ORDER

1. *Apprehending arrest the petitioner has preferred this pre-arrest bail application who is booked in Amarpur (Fullidumar) Police Station Case No. 77 of 2026, for the offence allegedly committed under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3/5 of BNS.*

2. *The case of prosecution is engendered upon a gravamen filed by one Dewa Devi with the allegations that on 24.01.2026, at about 3-pm, her husband Vakeel Prasad Yadav, went to outskirts on his call of nature. She saw that Manish Yadav came and entered the house of her neighbor Kailash Yadav. Thereafter, 1. Alok Kumar, 2. Nikesh Kumar @ Nikko, 3. Sandeep Kumar, 4. Rupam Kumari, 5. Dharmshila Devi, 6. Kailash Yadav, 7. Sanjay Yadav, 8. Chhotu Kumar, 9. Neelam Devi armed with deadly weapons were going towards outskirts. They all fenced her husband and started beating and then, they left him by presuming dead. She could not rescue her husband due to fear. When she went to her husband, her husband told Sandeep Kumar assaulted on his left knee with iron rod, resultantly his knee was fractured and he fell down. After that Alok Kumar gave a blow of sword on his right hand, resultantly his hand became injured. Nikesh Kumar stabbed spear on his left wrist. Rupam Kumari gave a blow of Kachiya on his left leg. Dharmshila Devi gave a blow of Dabiya on his left leg. Kailash Yadav pointed country made pistol on his chest and threatened to kill. Sanjay Yadav gave a blow of blackjack on his right leg. Kailash Yadav took his mobile worth of Rs. 20,000/- and Chhotu Kumar snatched his silver chain and assaulted him with Sang. Neelam Devi assaulted him with Khanti and after that he became unconscious. When she called police, the accused persons managed*

to escape.

3. *In oral arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he has falsely been implicated in this case whereas he is not named in the FIR. It is further submitted that other accused persons have already been granted pre-arrest bail by this very court vide A.B.P. No. 325 of 2026 and the case of the present petitioner is on lessor footing.*

4. *In counter, learned Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the pre-arrest bail application.*

5. *Heard rival submissions and perused the record. The record reveals that other accused persons have already been granted pre-arrest bail by this very court vide A.B.P. No. 325 of 2026 and the case of the present petitioner is on lessor footing. Therefore, keeping in view the law of parity, this court is inclined to grant the petitioner privilege of pre-arrest bail; resultantly, this pre-arrest bail application is allowed. It is, therefore, ordered that upon arrest or surrender of the petitioner within fortnight of receiving the instant order the petitioner be admitted to anticipatory bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of trial court subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. Out of the two sureties, one will be of the same village or close relative of petitioner.*

6. *File be consigned to the record room and that of trial court be sent back with a copy of this order.*
