This bail petition is filed on behalf of the accused person namely Anuj Kumar @ Hitalar, who is in custody since 26.05.2026, in connection with Bounsi P.S. Case no. 129/2026, under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2022.

The case of the prosecution in short is that on 25.05.2026 at about 07.30 P.M, the informant along with other police officials was on routine patrolling and vehicle checking. In that process they received a secret information that one one car bearing reg. no. BR01D 2688 is coming very fast from Hasdiha with liquor. On seeing the police he tried to escape but the police chased and nabbed him. On enquiry he disclose his name as Anuj Kumar @ Hitalar. On search altogether 129.6 litres of illicit foreign liquor was recovered from possession of the accused petitioner. After that, the police arrested the accused and seized the liquor.

Heard the learned Defence counsel as well as the learned Spl.P.P. for the State.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and is falsely implicated in this case due to dirty politics and also the instance of his enemies. It is stated that no bail application has been filed by the petitioner before your honour court or any higher court previously. It is stated that there is nothing recovered from his possession. It is further stated that the petitioner has no any criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 26.05.2026.

On the other hand, Learned Spl. P.P. opposed the bail petition.

Perused the case record. On Perusal it transpires that the accused petitioner is named in the F.I.R. Seizure list is available on the record. There is no any criminal antecedent against the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 26.05.2026. Considering the period of custody and on search of low amount of 129.6 liters of illicit foreign liquor were recovered from the possession of the accused petitioner.

Therefore, this court is of considered opinion that the accused petitioner deserve liberty of bail. Hence, this bail application stands allowed on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the court.
