1. Though, none on behalf of D-1 appeared, but an application dated 18.08.2025 seeking recusal of the P.O. from this case is filed. The application is vehemently opposed by the Ld. Counsel^u for the plaintiff and the defendant no-02. Perused the application. Similar applications with similar prayers filed by D-2 have already been rejected with speaking orders. D-1 could have impugned the dismissal orders in the Hon'ble High Court, however, D-1 has been filed the similar petition on each date in this court, hence, even the today's application for recusal is being dismissed with the cost of Rs.5000/- to be deposited in the Nazarat of the Civil Court, Begusarai. Let all the costs hitherto imposed be deposited by D-1 on or prior to next date, and let the receipt of deposit be submitted in this court on next date of hearing.

2. Today, DW-1-Sri. Gopal Singh was examined for defendant no-02. He was cross-examined on behalf of the plaintiff. Despite several calls, none appeared for D-1, hence, this witness is hereby discharged.

3. Put up this case on 28.08.2025 for defendant no-02's evidence. Defendant No-02 is impressed upon to lead his evidence as expeditiously as possible.
