The bail application under section 482 of the Bharat Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita ("BNSS") on behalf of the accused-Nikhil Kumar has been preferred inasmuch as he has been apprehending his arrest in connection with Matihani P.S. Case No-163/2025 registered for the offences under sections 108, 61(2) and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 ("B.N.S").
2. The prosecution story is based on written report of one, Manju Devi (informant) in which she has alleged that her daughter, namely, Lali Kumari was abducted by the accused persons, namely, Md. Arman, Md. Mahboob and Nikihil Kumar (petitioner) on 01.09.2025 in the early morning. As per the informant, the information regarding the fact of abduction has been given to the police, and police acted with promptitude, and recovered the daughter of the informant from the railway station wherein she was being planned to be taken to Delhi with the above said persons, and thereafter, daughter of the informant, after lot of persuasion, was brought in house. Unfortunately, daughter of the informant committed suicide in the evening on the same day inside her parents' house. Therefore, the FIR was filed with the allegations that the above said three accused persons have called her multiple times, and perused her to commit suicide.
3. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that mobile number, which has been alleged to be of the petitioner was not actually that of the petitioner, therefore, this petitioner has no role.
4. Having perused the record, I find that on 01.09.2025, the deceased-girl

was allegedly abducted by the above said accused persons, including the petitioner, and when she was caught by the police, and brought to home, then she committed suicide in the evening of the same day. It has also come in the record, the deceased has received mutiple calls on her mobile from the mobile numbers of the accused persons, including this petitioner during the intervening period. Even though the mobile number is not allegedly that of the petitioner, It is not uncommon to use the sim/mobile number issued in the name of the some other person. The name of this petitioner has come as one of the abductor's of deceased-girl, who committed suicide in the evening as she has been unsuccessful, inasmuch as she was caught from the railway station. The names of the accused persons, including this petitioner has been prominently taken in the said abudction, I believe custodial interrogation is requied, hence, I do not find prudent to confer the privilege of anticipatory bail to this petitioner. Hence his pre-arrest bail application is hereby **rejected**.
