ORDER

08.04.2026

1) The pre-arrest bail application under section 482 of Bharat Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita ("BNSS") on behalf of the accused-petitioner, namely, Ranjeet Kumar @ Ranjeet Kumar Roy has been preferred inasmuch as he has been apprehending his arrest in connection with Ballia P.S Case No- 533/2025, registered for the offences punishable under sections 191(2), 281, 125, 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 352, 351(2), 109(1) of the Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 ("B.N.S"), pending in the court of C.J.M., Begusarai.

2) The prosecution case is based on the fardbeyan of Subhash Kumar (informant) recorded by S.I., L.S. Tiwari, in which he has alleged that on 21.11.2025, at around 05:00 PM, while he was returning his home by motorcycle, and as soon as he reached near the temple of Bajrangbali near Shadipur Asarfa, then the miscreants on a scorio, and on two (2) motorcycles have halted. The petitioner was allegedly also one (1) of the miscreants, whose name was given as serial no.-2 in the FIR. As per informant, they collided the scorio with the informant, and his father with an intention to murder them by crushing by scorio, because of which their motorcycle fell down, and they also fell down on the road, thereafter the co-accused Pappu Ray exhorted their accomplices to kill the informant and his father. As per informant, on the exhortion by Pappu Ray, other miscreants attacked the informant, and his father by iron rod, and lathi and danda. As per informant, Pappu Ray, Mantun Ray and Chandan Ray have attacked upon him by iron rod because of which the informant's legs were broken.

3) From the perusal of the record, it appears that except the name of the petitioner

found mentioned in the fardbeyan, no specific allegation has been levelled against him. This petitioner has stated to have got no criminal antecedent. In which case, I am inclined to confer the benefits of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner/accused on furnishing the bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each subject to the condition as laid down U/s-482(2) of B.N.S.S., in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within 28 days from the date of this order.
