

ORDER

30.03.2026

1. The bail application under section 483 of Bharat Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita ("BNSS") on behalf of the accused, namely, Rajnish Kumar has been preferred inasmuch as he has been in judicial custody since 17.01.2026 in connection with Ballia P.S Case No- 34/2026 registered for the offences under sections 331(4), 305, 317(2) of Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 ("B.N.S").
2. From the perusal of the record, it appears that the petitioner has suffered the incarceration since 17.01.2026. Allegedly, petitioner was caught red-handed while committing theft, and from his possession, the aadhar card, scissors, made of iron and passbook of bank were found. It is not unusual to have the said materials in the house of any normal person. The petitioner has got clean antecedent. Ld. Addl. P.P has submitted that the petitioner has got one (1) criminal antecedent, however it has been stated that the petitioner's case has been disposed off from the juvenile court. It is trite that any acquittal under juvenile court shall not attach stigma. In this situation, I am inclined to direct to release the petitioner-accused on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of ld. Lower court.
3. The B.A. No- 280/026 is hereby **allowed**.
