ORDER

This is an application moved by the applicant/accused no.3
Ajaz Mohd. Shafi Khan to travel Colombo, Sri Lanka from 13/08/2026
to 31/08/2026 with a request to return of passport.

2. It is submitted that applicant Ajaj Mohammed Shafi Khan is a professional actor and he has received a bonafide invitation to visit Colombo, Sri Lanka from 13/08/2026 to 31/08/2026. He filed an invitation letter alongwith this application. The applicant has also filed the earlier travel abroad orders of this Court allowing him to travel abroad.

3. Prosecution has filed say and opposed the application on the ground that no justifiable ground is given to travel abroad.

4. Heard both sides. Perused record.

5. I have gone through the application. Earlier this Court has granted permission to the applicant to travel abroad on certain terms and conditions. Prosecution has not come with a case that applicant at any point of time breached any of the conditions. Therefore, considering the reasons stated and documents in support of the application, this court is of the view that no prejudice will be caused to the prosecution, if applicant is permitted to travel abroad i.e. Colombo, Sri Lanka, as prayed. In the result, following order is passed -

ORDER

1. Application (Exh.248) in Special Case no.1240/2021 is allowed. The permission to travel abroad, i.e. to **Colombo, Sri Lanka** is granted to the applicant/accused no.3 **Ajaz Mohd. Shafi Khan** for a period from 13/08/2026 to 31/08/2026, on the following terms and conditions :-

- (i) The accused no.3 shall furnish his complete itinerary, address during the stay abroad, mobile number, and copies of booked tickets prior to departure.

- (ii) The Investigating Officer / Concerned Authority to return the passport of the accused no.3 on proper verification and acknowledgment.
- (iii) The accused no.3 shall furnish Cash Security of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Only). The accused no.3 shall not be permitted to withdraw the amount of cash security until he returns back to India. The cash surety is already pending with the court, hence the same be treated as cash surety for present case, after due verification of such pending cash surety amount.
- (iv) The accused no.3 shall execute undertaking to return within the permitted period and to remain present before this Hon'ble Court on the dates fixed for hearing immediately upon his return.
- (v) The accused no.3 shall file a written undertaking that he will not seek any extension of stay abroad beyond the period granted by this Hon'ble Court.
- (vi) The accused no.3 shall surrender his passport to the Court immediately upon return to India.
- (vii) The accused no.3 shall restrict his travel only to the permitted country, i.e., Sri Lanka (Colombo), and shall not visit any other country without prior permission of this Hon'ble Court.
- (viii) The accused no.3 shall not contact, influence, or interfere with any witnesses during his stay abroad.
- (ix) In the event of breach of any of the above conditions, appropriate action including cancellation of bail and forfeiture of security shall be considered.
- (x) Application stands disposed of accordingly.
- (xi) The order is digitally signed; hence, it shall be uploaded on

the Case Information System (CIS), and the printout of the digitally signed order, additionally signed by me, shall be kept on record as the physical record is maintained by the Court.
