- 1) Today, a bail application on behalf of the accused- Bikki Kumar has been taken up for hearing. It is important to highlight that the bail bonds of this accused were forfeited vide order dated- 30.03.2026 because of his absence on 30.03.2026 when the case was taken up for hearing. As per ld. Counsel for the petitioner, the accused- Bikki Kumar was absent on 30.03.2026 because he was getting treatment of his mother in the hospital. The accused has produced the medical paper to substantiate his statements.
- 2) Having seen the medical record produced by the accused, it appears that accused was busy in getting his mother treated in the hospital, however, it was his duty to get the application u/s-317 of Cr.P.C. filed and moved by his advocate, which was not done, compelling the court to forfeit his bail bonds. The accused is undertaking to not repeat this conduct in the future. In the above scenario, I am inclined to enlarge this accused on bail subject he deposits the penalty of Rs- 3,000 (three thousands) in the Victim Compensation Fund in D.L.S.A, Begusarai. Let the receipt of the deposit of the cost in D.L.S.A, Victim Compensation Fund be given at the time of furnishing bail bonds. Let the bail bonds of Rs-10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each be furnished. Bail application filed by the accused-Bikki is hereby allowed.
