26.03.2026 – This bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner, **Rocky Pandey @ Rocket Pandey**, who is in custody since 26.12.2025 in Ratanpur P.S. Case No. 105/2025, registered u/s 304(2), 3(5) of B.N.S.

The prosecution case in brief as per the informant, Annapurna Devi, in her written application, she alleged that on 23.12.2025 at about 12:00 P.M. she withdraw Rs. 50,000/- from SBI Branch, Begusarai and was going to her house, on reaching near Sanichara Temple, all of sudden, two persons riding on a Blue Apache motorcycle came and snatched the Jhola containing Rs. 50,000/-, Mobile SIM No. 8051830838, Aadhar Card, PAN Card, Voter ID, Passbook and fled away. So, this case.

The Ld. counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. No BA or ABA has ever been filed on behalf of the petitioner before this court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna under any provision of law. The petitioner has four criminal antecedents vide Kankarbagh P.S. Case No. 850/2022, Maner P.S. Case No. 164/25, Kotwali P.S. Case No. 385/23 & Lakhisarai P.S. Case No. 279/2013. That the petitioner has been arrested on mere suspicion on 25.12.2025, but remanded on 26.12.2025. That no stolen property has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. That it is relevant to mention here the petitioner has been arrested at his residence and police officer taken Rs. 5100/- from the house of the petitioner. The petitioner is the owner of Rs. 5100/-. That the petitioner not confess his guilt but the police officer forcibly obtain his signature on different blank paper and prepare a forged fabricated confessional statement. That the

police officer did not take trouble to put petitioner on T.I.P. That the case of the petitioner comes under the purview of Satendra Kumar Antil Vs. CBI 2023 (I) SCC (Cri)1 and Naushad Ansari Vs. State of Bihar 2024(3) P.L.J.R. 398 on the maximum punishment is only 3 years. That the bail petition was moved before Ld. Lower Court has been pleased to reject the prayer of bail. It is relevant to mention here the Ld. Lower Court mention S. 304(2) BNS pertains to culpable homicide not amounting to murder. The Ld. Lower Court mention wrong fact in impugned order. That the petitioner is in custody since 26.12.2025. Lastly, he prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Ld. A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail.

Heard Ld. Counsel for both the sides and perused the record along with CD and on perusal of the same, it appears that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. There is allegation against the petitioner of snatching the bag containing Rs. 50,000/-, Mobile SIM No. 8051830838, Aadhar Card, PAN Card, Voter ID and Passbook of the informant from a blue Apache motorcycle. On perusal of the case diary, the statement of the informant has been recorded at para 02 of the CD. The witnesses in the case diary have supported the case of the prosecution vide para 03 & 04 of the CD. At para 09 of the CD, the blue Apache No. Plate is found in CCTV Footage and on verification of the no. plate, his owner name is registered as Guard Tiwary vide para 11 of the CD. At para 14 of the CD, it is found that the motorcycle is related to Tiwary Gang in which Guard Tiwary and present accused petitioner Rocky Pandey are the leaders and Rakshit Tiwary and Rohan Tiwary are the members of the said Gang. The criminal antecedent of the petitioner is available at para 18 of the CD. At para 33 of the CD, the petitioner has confessed his guilt. Chargesheet has been submitted against the present accused petitioner and he is in

custody since 26.12.2025.

Hence, considering the above-mentioned facts & circumstances and period of custody, I am inclined to grant the privilege of bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his prayer is hereby **allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below on following conditions:

- 1. One of the bailors should be local.**
- 2. The petitioner shall file an undertaking to not to pressurise witness or temper with evidence.**
- 3. The petitioner is directed to remain physically present as per the direction of the Ld. Trial Court.**
- 4. The petitioner shall file an undertaking to not to be indulged in offence of similar nature in future.**
