ORDER

1. The pre-arrest bail application under section 482 of Bharat Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita ("BNSS") on behalf of accused person, **Devendra Yadav** has been preferred inasmuch as he has been apprehending his arrest in connection with Ballia P.S. Case No-503/2025 registered for the offences under sections 126(2), 115(2), 352, 109(1) and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 ("B.N.S").

2. The prosecution story is based on written report of one, Manju Devi (informant), in which she has alleged that on 16.11.2025 at about 08.00 PM, the accused persons, namely, Saurav Kumar, Nishu Kumar, Natho Yadav, Abhishek Kumar, Ashok Yadav, and Devendra Yadav (petitioner) thronged in front of the house of the informant, and started hurling abuses, and when her husband, namely, Fakindra Yadav and her son-Sanjeev Kumar objected them from hurling abuses, then Ntho Yadav exhorted to beat the husband and son of the informant, on which Ashok Kumar caught hold of the husband of the informant, and thereafter, the co-accused, namely, Saurav Kumar and Nishu Kumar, with khanti and rod, assaulted husband and son of the informant. Abhishek Kumar and Devendra Yadav (petitioner) too allegedly assaltd them by lathi, due to which the son and husband of the informant received bleeding injuries, due to which, they fell down on the ground. As per informant, thereafter, Gadhi Yadav and Anita Devi came to rescue the aforesaid injured, then the accused persons fled away.

3. From the perusal of the written information, it appears that the husband of the informant and her son were assaulted by the accused persons. The allegation

against this petitioner is that he along with other co-accused persons thronged in front of the house of the informant, and started hurling abuses. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner. On the contrary, the main allegation is on Nishu Kumar, who allegedly assaulted the husband and son of the informant by khanti and rod. Moreover, having perused the injury report attached with the case diary, I find that husband-Fakindra Yadav of the informant has received lacerated wound over right side of forehead, whereas son-Sanjeev Kumar has received swelling over forehead. The injuries received by son-Sanjeev Kumar and the injury received by husband of the informant, namely, Fakindra Yadav were opined to be simple. Since, both the injuries were opined to be simple, and there are no specific allegations against this petitioner, I am inclined to direct to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each with subject to the condition as laid down U/s-482(2) of B.N.S.S in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within 28 days from the date of this order.

4. ABA No-494/2026 is hereby **allowed**.
