- 1) Today, a regular bail application on behalf of the accused/ petitioner, namely, Dhananjay Rai has been taken up for hearing inasmuch as the accused has been in judicial custody since 04.04.2026.
- 2) From the perusal of the record, it appears that the bail bonds of the accused were forfeited vide order dated- 03.01.2026. Since then, the case was listed several times, the court kept on waiting for the appearance of the accused, however the accused kept on evading his presence in the court, because of which the proceedings of the court didn't proceed further, thus the accused has prevented the flow of the trial. In such scenario, when the accused has just spent four (4) days in judicial custody, I am not inclined to enlarge on bail. The bail application of the accused- Dhananjay Rai is hereby rejected. The accused given liberty to prefer new bail application after one (1) month of the custody.
