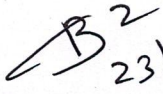

ORDER

23.05.2026

- 1) The pre-arrest bail application under section 482 of the Bharat Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita ("BNSS") on behalf of the accused-petitioner, namely, **Jai Prakash Rai** has been preferred inasmuch as he has been apprehending his arrest in connection with Nimachandpura P.S Case No-12/2004, registered for the offences punishable under sections 406, 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 of I.P.C., pending in the court of Sri Ashutosh Kumar, Ld. J.M.F.C., Begusarai.
- 2) Having noted that the P.S case is of 2004, and now the petitioner is coming in this court after twenty two (22) years, I have reasons to believe that some coercive orders, including NBW to process u/s- 82 Cr.P.C or 83 Cr.P.C might have been issued by the concerned court, where the case is pending. Let the photo-copy of the order-sheets in the Nimachandpura P.S Case No-12/2004 from the concerned court be summoned to the determine whether the process u/s- 82 Cr.P.C or 83 Cr.P.C has been issued against this petitioner or not. In case, the process u/s- 82 Cr.P.C or 83 Cr.P.C is already issued, the anticipatory bail application becomes infructuous, being not maintainable. Put up this case on **04.06.2026** for hearing, after receiving the aforesaid order-sheets.
- 3) O/C is directed to issue requisition for the photocopies of the order-sheets in the Nimachandpura P.S Case No-12/2004 from the Sri Ashutosh Kumar, Ld. J.M.F.C., Begusarai.
