- 1) Today, a bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused- Balram Singh @ Balram Chaudhary. As per the record, the petitioner was taken into custody vide order dated- 24.01.2026.
- 2) From the record, it is clear that the bail bonds of the accused were cancelled way back on 04.09.2023, more than two (2) and half (1/2) years back, and thereafter the accused had been absconding, so much so that even the process u/s-82 of Cr.P.C against the accused was proved to be futile. It is clear that when the bail was given to this accused in the past, he stopped coming in the court, thus misused the privilege of bail. Due to his absence from the court on the dates fixed, the trial gets delayed for over two (2) years. Since the accused is not reliable, has reputation of not honouring the bail conditions, therefore at this stage, when just charges have been framed, and evidence have not been yet started, let the accused be kept in judicial custody until the important prosecution witnesses be examined in the court. This accused shall have liberty to re-apply for the bail after the period of three (3) months from today, when the efforts of examining the important prosecution witnesses be made by the prosecution. Prosecution is directed to expedite the prosecution evidence. Let theailable warrants be sent to all non-official P.Ws returnable on 20.04.2026. Ld. Addl. P.P is also directed to use his good offices for procuring the prosecution witnesses.
- 3) In the above premises, the bail application filed by the accused-Balram Singh @ Balram Chaudhary is hereby **rejected**.
