1. An anticipatory bail petition dated 28.04.2026 has been filed on behalf of accused/petitioners namely; 1. **Bikki Kumar** s/o-Bhago Tanti, 2. **Bhago Tanti** s/o-Late Ashik Tanti and 3. **Agmanti @ Agam Devi** w/o-Bhago Tanti all R/o-village-Panchveer, P.S-S.Kamal, District-Begusarai who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Mufassil P.S Case No.751/2018 for committing an offence u/s-363, 366(A)/34 of IPC.

2. The prosecution case, in brief, is that on 03.12.2018 at about 09:00 a.m informant's daughter went to the Omar Girl High School for studying but she did not return back. Thereafter, informant began to search his daughter but she could not be traced. During inquiry, the informant came to know that all four named accused persons/petitioners enticed and kidnapped his daughter with intention of marriage. So this case.

3. The Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners submitted that the petitioners have not filed any bail either anticipatory bail or regular bail before this court or any higher court. It is further submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and they have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. There is no iota of evidence against the petitioner. Further submitted that victim is living in her Sasural happily and enjoying her marriage life. There is no criminal antecedent of the petitioners. He further submitted that petitioners are ready to abide all the conditions imposed by the court, so petitioners may be released on bail.

4. On the other hand, the Addl Spl. PP for State opposed the prayer of bail to the petitioners.

5. Heard both the sides and perused the case diary. On perusal of statement u/s-183 of BNSS of victim girl, it shows that she has not supported the prosecution case of kidnapping with an intent to compel her for marrying. The victim girl is now present with her three children and is living with her husband. The marriage was solemnized in the year 2018 and both the parties are residing together as husband and wife. A joint photograph is also annexed with the record. In the present circumstances, no fruitful purpose will be served by taking the petitioners into custody. There is no apprehension of absconding or tampering with the evidence. As per case diary, there are no sufficient materials available on

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record against the petitioners. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. The petitioners are named in FIR, registered offences u/s-363, 366(A)/34 of IPC and investigation is still going on.

6. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances of the case; this Court inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, their prayer is hereby allowed. The petitioners are directed to be released on anticipatory bail in event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below with a condition:-

1. The petitioners shall furnish an undertaking to the effect that they shall participate in the investigation.
