22.06.2026	IN THE MATTER OF :- Sanjay Rai, S/O- Parmanand Rai, aged about 42 years, R/O- village – Samsipur, Bichli Diyara, Ward no- 7, P.S.- Bachhwara, District Begusarai, (Bihar) Petitioner Versus The state of Bihar Opposite Party <u>ORDER</u> This regular bail application has been preferred by petitioner namely, Sanjay Rai, who is in custody since 10.04.2026 in connection with Bachhwara P.S. case no. 83 of 2025 dated 12.03.2025, pending before the Court of C.J.M., Begusarai. This record has been received by this Court, vide. order dated 11.06.2026 of Ld. Principal District and Sessions Judge, Begusarai, for hearing and disposal. In the course of hearing of this bail petition, the case diary was called for and the same has been received and available on the record for perusal of this Court. Heard; Deepak Kumar Jha Learned Advocate for the petitioner and Sri Bipin Roy, Learned A.P.P. for the State. This Bachhwara P.S. case no. 83 of 2025 dated 12.03.2025, has been registered for the offences punishable under Sections- 115(2), 127(1), 109, 351, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS against the above named accused-petitioner. As per written application of the informant the prosecution case, in brief, is that, on 12.03.2025 the informant along with his two brothers went to their uncle's house for casual meeting. In the meantime, five F.I.R. named accused-persons including petitioner started arguing with the informant. Accused petitioner Sanjay Rai stated

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that hut of informant is situated on his land. On objection made by the informant; accused Parmanand Rai abused and ordered to kill the informant. Then, accused petitioner Sanjay Rai assaulted the informant with bamboo stick with intention to kill him, so informant severely injured on his head. When informant's brothers tried to save the informant, then, accused-persons abused and assaulted them also. The condition of informant was critical and he was referred from Primary Health Centre Bachhwara to Begusarai. Accused persons threatened the informant to be killed in case of filing any case. Hence this case.

The Ld. Advocate for the petitioner has submitted that the instant case has been falsely registered against the petitioner. Further submitted that earlier on behalf of the petitioner an anticipatory bail application has been filed before this learned court vide. A.B.A. No.- 1086/25 which was rejected on 23.05.25 thereafter petitioner has filed anticipatory bail application before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide Cri. Misc. No. 48949/25 which was also rejected on 18.11.25 and no bail petition is pending in any court. It is further submitted that petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Further submitted that there are two criminal history against the accused petitioner. Further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 10.04.2026. Hence, prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. appearing for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both the sides and perused the case record. Perusal of the case record transpires that the allegation attributed this accused-petitioner is that on the alleged date of occurrence the accused-petitioner assaulted the informant with bamboo on his head. The witnesses in para 8, 9, 10 and 11 the witnesses have supported the prosecution case. Further, in para 14 of the case diary the independent witness has

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stated that there is land dispute between the parties and on the alleged date of occurrence the informant sustained injury on his head due to hut falling on his head. Perusal of the injury report transpires that there is lacerated wound on right parietal region which is simple caused by hard and blunt substance and C.C.T. of brain shows linear fracture. The accused-petitioner is in custody since 10.04.2026.

Under the fact and circumstances discussed here in above and considering the period of custody accused petitioner namely, **Sanjay Rai** directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below.
