1. The instant regular bail application has been filed by and on behalf of the above named accused/petitioner who is in custody since 11.03.2026 in connection with **Singhaul P.S Case No. 71 of 2026** for having committed offences punishable under sections 103(1), 61(2), 3(5) B.N.S and 27 Arms Act.
2. It is submitted by the leaned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and has falsely been implicated in this case due to ill motive of the informant and no any other bail petition in connection with this case has either been filed by the petitioner in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna earlier. It is further submitted by the learned counsel that no case U/s-103(1) or 61(2) of B.N.S and 27 of the Arms Act is made out against the petitioner. Since as per only three named accused persons in the FIR executed the murder of the father of the informant by firing bullets on him and since the house of the petitioner is situated adjacent to the place of occurrence, therefore, only on suspicion the police apprehended the petitioner and recorded his confessional statement and made him accused in the instant case. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Lastly, a prayer is made to grant bail to the petitioner as the petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond as directed by this court.
3. On the other hand, the learned Addl. P.P vehemently opposed the prayer of petitioner and submitted that though the petitioner is not named in the FIR, however, the petitioner played a crucial role in execution of the murder of the father of the informant as he worked as liner to facilitate the smooth execution of the crime. He further submitted that there is strong apprehension that if the petitioner would be released at this stage, he may try to influence or intimidate the witnesses during the trial. Therefore, the petitioner does not deserve bail.
4. Briefly stated allegation as per the charge sheet is that on 09.03.2026 three persons namely Rajeev Sah, Lalan Mahto and Chandan Sah at 13:15 hours allegedly opened fire on the father of the informant resultantly he sustained bullet injuries and during the course of treatment he

died that it is further the case of the prosecution that on 05.03.2026 one convicted accused namely Santosh Chaudhary from the Jail on mobile phone had threatened the father of the informant to kill him.

5. From perusal of record, it is evident that three motorcycle borne assailants allegedly caused firearms injuries to the father of the informant in broad day light causing the death of the father of the informant. Record further reveals that though the petitioner was not named in the FIR however, during the course of investigation he was found to be indulged in facilitating the smooth execution of the crime and allegedly worked as liner. Record also reveals that the other co-accused persons, who have been named in the FIR are having very rich criminal antecedent and are allegedly indulged in running a syndicate that used to grab the land using muscle powers and extorting money from property dealers. Though the charge sheet has been filed in this case, however, the charges are yet to be framed in this case and evidence is yet to be commenced.
6. In view of aforesaid discussion as well as keeping in mind the nature of accusation and gravity of offence as well as stage of this case, this court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the instant bail petition is hereby **rejected**.
