ORDER

17.06.2026

1) The pre-arrest bail application under section 482 of Bharat Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita ("BNSS") on behalf of the accused-petitioner-**Sahil Chauhan** has been preferred inasmuch as he has been apprehending his arrest in connection with Matihani P.S Case No- 79/2020, registered for the offences punishable under sections 406, 420 r/w 34 of I.P.C, pending in the court of Sri Rakesh Kumar, Ld. J.M.F.C., Begusarai.

2) From the perusal of the records, it appears that this petitioner was working as the event manager, situated at Patna. With the petitioner, there is no privity of contract between the complainant and the Sabbir Kumar. Moreover, the present case is the case based on the documentary evidence. The petitioner appears to be framed in this case, because petitioner was an event manager situated at Patna. Furthermore, the petitioner is undertaking to cooperate in the investigation and trial. Also, the petitioner is the person of clean antecedents, in which case, I am inclined to grant the privilege of pre-arrest bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two (2) sureties of like amount each subject to the condition as laid down U/s-482(2) of B.N.S.S., in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within 28 days from the date of this order. Let the written undertaking be furnished at the time of furnishing the bail bonds that the petitioner-accused would remain available for the investigation and for the trial, and non-cooperation of this petitioner during investigation and trial would entail the cancellation of his bail, on application made on behalf of the prosecution.

3) Consequently, the A.B.A No-1136/2026 is hereby **ALLOWED**.
