ORDER

- 1) In B.A. No- 617/2026, the petitioners-accused persons, namely, (i) **Chhotu Kumar**, (ii) **Ankit Kumar**, and (iii) **Ankesh Kumar** have applied for regular bail inasmuch as they have been in judicial custody since 25.04.2026. In A.B.A. No- 1158/2026, the petitioners-accused persons, namely, (i) **Abdhesh Rai @ Abdhesh Patel**, (ii) **Ajit Kumar**, and (iii) **Malkhan Khan @ Malkhan Rai** has applied for pre-arrest bail inasmuch as they have been apprehending their

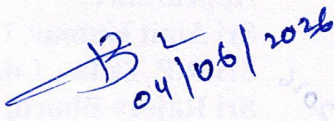
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arrest. Both the bail applications have arisen out of the common P.S. bearing Matihani P.S Case No-84/2026, registered for the offence punishable u/ss-126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 303(2), 76, 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 ("B.N.S"), pending in the court of Ld. A.C.J.M-1st, Begusarai.

2) From perusal of the records, it appears that because of the blows given by the accused persons/petitioners, as many as two (2) persons of the informant's family were injured. The injured-Deadhar Rai has received three (3) grievous injuries on his vital parts, including on his head, and the injured-Sudhanshu Rai has received two (2) simple injuries. The petitioners were allegedly involved in assaulting the informant, and her family members, and they have caused the grievous injuries. All the petitioners are said to have shared the common intentions to cause fatal injuries likely to cause death. The causing of grievous injuries can not be encourage by giving the petitioners discretionary relief of bail. All of these petitioners were also allegedly involved in causing the aforesaid grievous injuries, therefore, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of bail to any of them. The petitioners have failed to make out the case for their respective bail and anticipatory bail.

3) Consequently, the B.A No-617/2026 & A.B.A No-1158/2026 are hereby **DISMISSED.**
