1. An anticipatory bail petition dated 26.05.2026 has been filed on behalf of accused/petitioner namely; **Jogee Kumar @ Jogi Kumar Ray** s/o-Late Neval Ray R/o-village-Chamtha Namber, Ward No.4, P.S-Bachhwara, Dist.-Begusarai who is apprehending his arrests in connection with Bachhwara P.S Case No.382/2024 for committing an offence u/s-87, 3(5) of BNS.

2. The prosecution case in brief is that the informant Jogi Ray has alleged that accused Ashok Ray had developed a love affair with his wife Mithu Kumari, age 24 years, through mobile, for which a Panchayati was held on 15/06/2024 and Ashok Ray was warned. Thereafter on 24/10/2024 accused Ashok Ray, Pankaj Ray, Shankar Ray and Ram Iqbal Ray assaulted the informant and abused him and a case vide Bachhwara P.S. Case No. 370/2024 was lodged. It is further alleged that on 30/10/2024 at about 12:01 PM the above-said accused persons along with 5 unknown persons came armed with weapons and kidnapped the informant's wife Mithu Kumari and his son Bhola Kumar, age 5 years by creating undue pressure and took them away. More than 10 days have passed but there is no information about them. So this case.

3. The Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of accused/petitioner submitted that no any B.A or ABA has been filed before this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. It is further submitted that the petitioner is innocent, have committed no offence, and he has been falsely implicated in this case. There is no criminal antecedent of the petitioner. The petitioner is the husband of Mithu Kumari and petitioner protested the illicit relation of Mithu Kumar with Ashok Rai because of this reason Mithu Kumari gave the name in her statement u/s-164 of Cr.P.C. He further submitted that petitioner is ready to abide all the conditions imposed by the court, so petitioner may be released on bail.

4. On the other hand, the Addl Spl. PP for State as well as learned counsel for the informant has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail to the petitioner.

5. Having heard both the parties and perused the case record along with case diary. On perusal of record, it appears that petitioner is the husband of victim and the serious allegations have been made against him. The statement of the victim recorded u/s-183 of BNSS prima facie supports the allegations against her husband/petitioner is that her husband/petitioner Jogee Kumar @ Jogi Kumar Ray, contracted a second marriage after not receiving dowry in the form of a vehicle and thereafter stopped providing her food. She has stated that she was confined in

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a room by her husband and Jaleshar Kumar, and was assaulted by her husband, co-wife Kajal Kumari, mother-in-law Indu Devi, brother-in-law Anil Kumar, sister-in-law Seema, and uncle-in-law Jugal Ray and his wife Manita Devi. She has also stated that one of her teeth was broken during the assault. The victim further alleged misappropriation of her money and jewellery. Moreover, the charge-sheet has been submitted u/s-85, 115(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner and others.

6. Considering the gravity of the offence, nature of allegations, and materials available on record including the statement of the victim u/s 183 BNSS; I do not find it appropriate to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner namely, Jogee Kumar @ Jogi Kumar Ray is hereby **rejected**.
