- 1) Today, PW-2-Mithilesh Kumar Singh is examined, cross-examined, and discharged. Also, PW-3-Rakesh Kumar Gupta is examined, cross-examined, and discharged. Put up this case on 10.09.2026 for P.E. From the perusal of records, it is clear that, in this case, the informant-Raj Kumar, S/O-Moti Paswan has not appeared in this court for getting his depositions recorded. This court has issued several processes, but not to avail. It appears that the informant is avoiding his depositions in this case. Vide this order, office clerk is directed to issue NBW, returnable on 10.09.2026, against the informant-Raj Kumar, S/O-Moti Paswan immediately.
- 2) It is very important to highlight that on behalf of the accused-Vikram Kumar, a petition u/s- 451 r/w 457 of Cr.P.C for releasing his motorcycle bearing registration no-BR09AG2063 in the name of the registered owner-Phakeer Paswan has been filed way back on 05.08.2023 seeking the report from the I.O-Rakesh Kumar Gupta, S/O- and the D.T.O. The report from D.T.O has been obtained on 25.08.2023, however, the report from the I.O has not been obtained so far for the best reasons known to the I.O. It appears that the above motorcycle has been sold by the I.O in collusion with other police staffs of S. Kamal P.S., and they have misappropriated the sale consideration, causing wrongful loss to the accused and the registered owner. By selling the above motorcycle, the I.O has committed the punishable cognizable offence. In this scenario, this court expresses its strong displeasure, and requires the I.O to make good the loss to the accused and the registered owner for selling the motorcycle. But prior thereto, let the written explanation be filed on behalf of I.O in this court within ten (10) days from today as to why the disciplinary action be not initiated against the I.O. Let the copy of this order be sent to Ld. S.P, Begusarai for his necessary actions in this regard. Also, let the copy of this order be handed over to I.O. In case, no written explanation from the I.O is obtained within the prescribed date, the amount would be fixed by the court, and would be directed to be recovered from the salary of the I.O-Rakesh Kumar Gupta.
- 3) Put up this case on 10.09.2026 for P.E.
