ORDER

- 1) The bail application under section 483 of Bharat Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita ("BNSS") on behalf of the petitioner-accused, namely, **Mantun Singh @ Ultar** has been preferred inasmuch as he has been in judicial custody since 03.05.2026 in connection with Bachhwara P.S Case No- 451/2025, registered for the offences punishable under sections 109, 352, 309(5) of the Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 ("B.N.S") & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, pending in the court of Ld. C.J.M., Begusarai.
- 2) The prosecution story is based on the fardbeyan of Shivam Kumar (informant), wherein he has alleged that on 19.12.2025 at around 10:30, the informant along with his cousin Bittu Kumar was returning home by motorcycle, and when they reached on N.H.-28, three criminals came and stood before their motorcycle, and started looting them, including snatching their mobiles, and when the informant and his cousin objected, then one of the miscreants fired gunshot.
- 3) From the perusal of records, it appears that the FIR was lodged against unknown persons, however in para no-34, the confessional statements of the co-accused-Dilkhush Kumar, the name of this petitioner- Mantun Singh @ Ultar has come. The confessional statement of the co-accused is a very weak piece of evidence. In the records, apart from the confession of co-accused, there are no incriminating materials against the accused. This petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Additionally, the petitioner has suffered one (1) month in judicial custody. Hence, I am inclined to direct the release of the petitioner-accused- **Mantun Singh @ Ultar** on bail on furnishing the bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. concerned court.
- 4) Consequently, the B.A. No- 783/2026 filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner is hereby **ALLOWED**.
