

In the court of District & Additional Sessions Judge-VII, Begusarai**A.B.A. No.- 1244/2026****Laldhari Sahni & Another Vs. State of Bihar****Present:- Sri Navin Kumar Srivastava (D.& A.S.J.-VII)**

22.07.2026	1. Heard learned Counsel on the Anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the petitioners namely 1. Laldhari Sahni, S/o Late Munggi Sahni, 2. Rajesh Sahni, S/o- Laldhari Sahni, who has apprehension of arrest in connection with Teghara P.S. Case, No.- 137/2026, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 118(2), 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. pending in the court of C.J.M./Concerned Court, Begusarai. Also heard the learned Addl. P.P. for the State. 2. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the accused petitioners are quite innocent and they have committed no offence. No B.A. & A.B.A. has ever been filed in this case for the accused petitioners before any court. The accused petitioners have no criminal history as per instructions. The allegation is denied no such incident happened. Due to dispute arising out of use of Rasta land to this false case is lodged. The informant is a litigant lady who has falsely implicated the entire male and female members of the family of petitioner No.-01. 3. Learned APP strongly objected the Anticipatory bail application and submitted that the allegation against the petitioners is very serious. So, he requested to reject the anticipatory bail application. 4. The prosecution case is that the informant Smt. Shobha Devi has alleged that on 15.03.2026 at about 1:30 PM, the accused persons namely Laldhari Sahni, Rajesh Sahni, Ramiya Devi, Neetu Kumari, and the wife of Rajesh Sahni (name not known) were blocking the only way to her house by putting bamboo, poles, and wooden sticks. When she objected and requested them not to block the only passage, all the accused persons started abusing her and became aggressive. During the incident, Rajesh Sahni hit her on the head with a hammer, due to which her head was badly injured and she started bleeding. She also received injuries on her hand. Due to the assault, she became unconscious. It is further alleged that when she was unconscious, all the accused persons together took away a gold ornament (chakti) from her neck. On hearing noise, nearby people came there and saved her. She further stated that during treatment, 12 stitches were given on her head and 2 stitches on her left hand. She has also stated that she is a poor widow and this is the only way to enter and exit her house. Lastly,	

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Contd. 22.07.2026	she alleged that Laldhari Sahni and Rajesh Sahni are threatening her to transfer her land in their name, otherwise they will kill her. They also claim that police is under their control and no one can harm them. She further alleged that they have links with criminal persons in the area. 5. Heard both sides and perused the record and C.D. In this case the petitioners are named in the F.I.R. As per case diary, in supervision, the case under Sections- 126(2), 115(2), 74, 118(2), 351(2) and 3(5) of the B.N.S. has been found true against the petitioners. The injury report of the informant Shobha Devi, shows that all the injuries are simple in nature. The petitioners has no criminal antecedents. The case is triable by Magistrate. Therefore, keeping in mind the allegations against the petitioners and the nature of the injuries, I find it proper to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, the Ld. Court below is directed to release the petitioners, on arrest or surrender before the court below within one month from the communication of this order. They shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below. (Dict.) Sd/- Dist. & Addl.
