The instant regular bail application has been filed on behalf of the above named accused person who is in custody since 09.05.2026 in connection with **Bachhwara P.S Case No. 398 of 2025** for having committed offences punishable under sections **115(2), 126(2) 109, 3(5) of B.N.S & 27 Arms Act.**
2. It is submitted by the leaned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and has falsely been implicated in this case and no any other bail petition in connection with this case has either been filed by the petitioner in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna earlier and the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that the petitioner and the informant are own gotia and they are descendants of common ancestor and there is land dispute between them. This petitioner has committed no offence and he has maliciously been implicated in this false case due to revenge and pressurize to this petitioner to compromise the Bachhwara P.S Case No. 337/2024 which was lodged by the father of this petitioner against the informant of this case and his family members. The petitioner is a daily labourer. It is further submitted that no recovery has ben made from this petitioner and one co-accused Ram Pravesh Rai has been granted bail by this learned court on 10.02.2026. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 09.05.2026. Lastly, a prayer is made to grant bail to the petitioner.
3. On the other hand, the learned Addl. P.P opposed the prayer of petitioner and submitted that the petitioner is named in the FIR. There is allegation of assault the informant's mother and his sister against the petitioner and others. Therefore, the petitioner does not deserve regular bail.
4. The prosecution case, in brief is that on 26.10.2025 at about 10:00 A.M, the informant took his cattle for grazing. In the meantime, at about 02:00 P.M, Pandaw Yadav stated him that his father was fired by gun shot. Thereafter, the informant went to his house and found that his father was lying on the ground and four FIR named accused persons including petitioner and 4-5 unknown persons were assaulting the informant's mother and two sisters with lathi. Vivek started assaulting the informant. The informant's mother stated him that accused Ravin Kumar fired gun-shot at his father. Ravin Kumar also fired gun-shot at informant, but he saved himself. When villagers came there, then the accused persons fled from there after committing firing.

5. On perusal of case diary and other material available on the record, it is evident that the allegation against the petitioner Ravin Kumar is that he shot the informant's father and thereafter, he also fired over the informant who somehow managed to save himself. The allegation against the petitioner is direct and quite serious in nature.
6. Considering the seriousness of the allegation as well as the fact that he is the main assailant who fired over the informant's father, I do not find it proper to grant the privilege of regular bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his bail prayer is **rejected**.
