The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused person namely **1. Gayatri Devi** who is apprehending her arrest in connection with Mansurchak P.S. Case No. 27 of 2020 for having committed offences punishable under section 135 of Electricity Act.

Prosecution story in brief as per the informant is that, on 19.03.2020 a raiding operation was started by the informant Vivek Kumar Junior Engineer Electricity Rural Area Teghra in connection with the electricity thief in his jurisdiction. During the operation the premises of twelve persons were raided at 04:15 PM the raiding team raided the premises of Ajeet Kumar in his commercial premises illegal connection from the electricity wire by hooking into electricity line. In which revenue loss of Rs. 59172 was caused to the concerned company.

Learned advocate on behalf of the petitioners have submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and she has committed no offence. The petitioner has not moved any bail petition in connection with this case either in your honour's court or in Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. All the allegation as alleged against the petitioner are false and hyperbolic. On these grounds, it has been prayed that the anticipatory bail application of the petitioner be allowed.

Learned counsel for the State vehemently opposed the prayer of the bail of the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

After perusal of FIR & Material available on record it is apparent that the accused petitioner **1. Gayatri Devi** has not named in the FIR. There is no criminal

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antecedent against this accused petitioner. An affidavit has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Gyatri Devi in which her son Ajeet Kumar stated that this petitioner is his mother. His mother Gyatri Devi is suffering from heart disease and she was treated by Dr. Ranjan Kumar Choudhary on dated 05.04.2026 & Dr. Rajnish Kumar on dated 05.04.2026. Her Medical tests report was submitted on behalf of the petitioner.

Date of FIR 20.03.2020 and charge-sheet has been submitted. The punishment prescribed for sections 135 of Electricity Act is less than 3 years. Hence, on the basis of the material available on record, arguments of advocates observations made and the inference drawn the court is of the opinion that the relief may be granted to the petitioner as prayed in his petition.

ORDER

Accordingly, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousands) each with two sureties of like amount each in event of their arrest or surrender before the learned trial court below within four weeks from receipt of this order, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S.
