13.07.2026	IN THE MATTER OF :- Sonu Mallik S/O- Sita Ram Mallik, aged about 19 years Resident of village – Daniyalpur, Pokharapar, Ward no. 06, P.S.- Teghra, District Samastipur, (Bihar) Petitioner Versus The state of Bihar Opposite Party <u>ORDER</u> This regular bail application has been preferred by petitioner namely, Sonu Mallik who is in custody since 04.05.2026 in connection with Teghra P.S. case no. 218 of 2026 dated 03.05.2026, pending before the Court of C.J.M., Begusarai. This record has been received by this Court, vide. order dated 09.07.2026 of Ld. Principal District and Sessions Judge, Begusarai, for hearing and disposal. In the course of hearing of this bail petition, the case diary was called for and the same has been received and available on the record for perusal of this Court. Heard; Manoj Kumar Sanehi, Learned Advocate for the petitioner and Sri Manoj Thakur, Learned A.P.P. for the State. This Teghra P.S. case no. 218 of 2026 dated 03.05.2026, has been registered for the offences punishable under Sections- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 74, 109, 303(2), 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. against the above named accused-petitioner. As per written application of the informant the prosecution case, in brief, is that, on 03.05.2026 at about 06:30 AM, Ravi Mallik, Bikram Mallik, Sonu Mallik, Sumit Mallik, and Ajay Mallik began construction work on the informant's land when the informant objected, then namely Biruju

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Mallik, Sitaram Mallik, Manoj Mallik, Ram Vilash Mallik, Bunit Mallik, Bikram Mallik, Ajay Mallik, Raja Mallik, Badal Mallik, Rakesh Mallik, Ranjeet Mallik, Sonu Mallik, Ravi Mallik, Sumit Mallik, and some unknown persons rushed towards her armed with weapons Bamboo, poles and bricks and began assaulting her. Further, stated that Sitaram Mallik grabbed her by the heirs and threw her to the grounds. Birju Mallik injured the informant's finger. Bikram Mallik assaulted the informant's daughter-in-law Poonam Devi, then Sonu Mallik, Ravi Mallik, Bunti Mallik, Ajay Mallik, Raja Mallik and Sumit Mallik began assaulted Vishal Mallik, Sonu Mallik struck him on the head with the Butt of a pistol, as a result of which he became injured. Ravi Mallik snatched a golden pendant from her neck. Birju Mallik and Manoj Mallik struck the informant's son on the face with the butt of a pistol, he became injured. Hence this case.

The Ld. Advocate for the petitioner has submitted that the instant case has been falsely registered against the petitioner. Further submitted that Petitioner has not moved in this learned court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna earlier either for grant of anticipatory bail or regular bail in the present case. It is further submitted that petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Further submitted that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. It has been submitted that there is compromise between both the parties and a compromise petition duly signed by both the parties has been filed. Hence, prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. appearing for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both the sides and perused the case record. Perusal of the written application of the informant transpires that the specific allegation attributed against

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the accused petitioner is that on the alleged date of occurrence the accused petitioner along with other co-accused assaulted Vishal Mallik the son of the informant. It is further alleged that the accused-petitioner assaulted the son of the informant with butt of the pistol. In para 2, 6, the witnesses have supported the allegation of assault. Perusal of the injury report transpires that there is lacerated wound over paritel and frontal region of scalp caused by hard and blunt substance. The accused-petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The accused petitioner is in custody since 04.05.2026.

Under the fact and circumstances discussed here in above and considering the period of custody accused petitioner namely, **Sonu Mallik** is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below.
