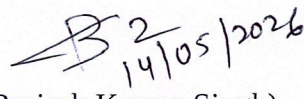

1. Today, the arguments on behalf of the rest accused persons are heard in part. Ld. Senior counsel, Sri S.K Sinha is seeking one (1) more day to conclude his arguments. The time prayed is granted. Put up this case on 18.05.2026 for the rest of the arguments on behalf of the accused persons.
2. The bail application on behalf of the accused-Ramashish Yadav, who was taken into custody after forfeiting his bail bonds on complaint of the victim on 07.05.2026 that the accused has demolished the structure of her house, has been taken for hearing. On 07.05.2026, a video was shown in which the accused-Ramashish Yadav was found destroying the structures of the house by force. The video recording recorded by the mobile of the victim is shown to the court, and the copy of which is annexed with the record in pen drive. The court found the behaviour of the accused-Ramashish Yadav atrocious. However, having spent seven (7) days in custody, the accused appeared remorseful today. The accused, when appeared in this court has submitted that he would not repeat the similar conducts in the future while he would be on bail. He has undertaken not to misuse the privilege of bail. He has also undertaken to cooperate in trial, and remain physically present throughout the remaining trial. Since, accused has already suffered seven (7) days of incarceration, and now is repentant on his atrocious conduct, and he has earlier been on bail, and has been sincerely attending the proceedings of this court, I am inclined to direct to release him on bail. Let him be released on furnishing the bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousands) with two (2) sureties of the like amount. Let the aforesaid undertaking be filed on behalf of the accused. In view of above, the bail application filed on behalf of the accused-Ramashish Yadav is hereby **ALLOWED.**
