1. The petitioner Pappu Sahni seeks regular bail in connection with Cheriyabariyarpur P.S. Case No- 35/2024 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 354(B), 379, 385, 387, 504, 506, 34 of IPC of IPC. The copy of same has been served to the Ld. APP for state. Ld. Counsels for the party have been exhaustively heard.

2. The case of the prosecution is in written application of Jaijai Ram Mahto who stated that on 19.02.2024 at about 11.30 pm 7-8 unknown persons came to his brick kilns armed with pistols and bamboo sticks and started abusing to labourers working there and told them to say the informant if he would not pay *rangdari* of ten lakh rupees then he would be killed. They also assaulted the labourers and molested the women labourers. Before leaving the spot the accused persons again threatened to give *rangdari* of ten lakh rupees if their owner wanted to stay alive. After the incident the unknown accused persons went to another brick kilns and they also abused and assaulted the labourers there and told them to convey the message to the brick kilns' owner to give *rangdari* of ten lakh rupees or else they would kill the brick kiln owner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and he has not committed any offence. The petitioner never filed any bail application under any provision of law earlier or either before this Id. court or Hon'ble High Court. The petitioner has 12 criminal antecedents. The petitioner is

in judicial custody since 04.03.2024. It is further relevant to hear that the present case is currently at the stage of evidence. Entire allegation as alleged in the FIR against the petitioner is maliciously false and the petitioner is falsely implicated in the case, due to dirty police politics. The petitioner is ready to comply with all the terms and conditions imposed by the Id .court u/s 483 of BNSS. On these grounds the Ld. counsel prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

4. Learned counsel for the state opposed the prayer of regular bail to the petitioner.

5. Heard Ld. Counsels and perused the case record. At the outset it be mentioned that the LCR was called for and the same has been annexed with the record for perusal. On perusal of FIR, case diary and other material available on judicial record this case was registered for the offences punishable under sections- 323, 354(B), 379, 385, 387, 504, 506, 34 of IPC against unknown accused persons. The petitioner is not named in FIR rather he confessed his guilt himself in his confessional statement in para-29 of case diary that he along with other culprits came to the brick kilns of informant and one other, armed with pistols and bamboo sticks and started abusing and told the labourers to convey the messages to the owners of both the Brick-kilns that if they would not pay *rangdari* of ten lakh rupees then they would be killed. They also assaulted the labours and molested the female labourers. As per para-30 of the case diary, the petitioner having 13 criminal antecedents, which shows that the petitioner is habitual criminal. There is ample material in para-25, 29 & 30 of case diary against the petitioner. The allegations are serious and attract severe punishment. Hence, considering the long criminal antecedents of petitioner as well as facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the opinion that the petitioner does not deserves bail. Accordingly, the bail application stands rejected.
