This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 10.4.2026 in connection with Sono P.S.Case No.273/2025 registered for the offence U/s.126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 109, 308(2), and 303(2) read with 3(5) of B.N.S. pending in the court of A.C.J.M.,2nd,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Shishupal Kumar Singh,the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Vikas Kumar has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Sono Police Station alleging therein that he happens to be Chief Manager of Darshan Bharat Gas Agency situated at Mahugain (Banadih). It is further alleged that the said distributorship of the LPG is in the name of his wife and when on 27.9.2025 at 7 a.m., he sent 30 cylinders of L.P.G. through a vehicle for distribution among the consumers alongwith his son, then after some time,he got an information that the F.I.R. named accused persons including the petitioner had taken the possession of the vehicle alongwith aforesaid cylinders and demanding Rs. One lakh as extortion money, and on protest by his son, he assaulted him and snatched Rs.14145/- from his son. After getting information, the informant rushed to the place of occurrence and when he inquired about the incident, then the accused Sabir (petitioner) has struck on his head by an iron rod, consequently, he got injured. Thereafter, another accused Moin khan @ Golden snatched a gold chain from his neck. Thereafter, all the accused persons started assaulting him and he was any how saved by his son and other local persons, and he was admitted to Sono hospital, but taking account of his seriousness, he was referred to P.M.C.H.Patna,and thereafter, he has filed the instant case.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. Similarly situated other accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail by the Hon'ble Court. The petitioner has clean antecedent, and injury inflicted to the informant is simple in nature which is mentioned in paragraph 51 of the case diary.

5. The learned P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that the injury inflicted to the informant is simple in nature, and the petitioner has clean antecedent. Moreover, other accused persons have been granted privilege of anticipatory bail.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
