09.03.2026	<p>Accused person namely, Karelal Singh has filed their attendance. Accused person is present before the court with their Ld.counsel. Thereafter Ld. Defence counsel submits before the court that the prosecution failed to adduced any witness in support of his case. It's matter of no evidence. So, kindly proceed in this case and accused person may be acquitted from all the charges levelled against them. Thereafter, court directed to accused person to appear before the court with their Ld. Counsel after a while for hearing and order.</p> <p>Later on;</p> <p>Above named accused person namely Karelal Singh is physically present before the court with their Ld counsel and prays before the court that the prosecution did not adduced any other witnesses during trial in support of this case. There is no piece of evidence available on the record against the accused person to warrant their conviction.</p> <p>Accordingly accused person should be acquitted in this case on the basis of lack of evidences.</p> <p>Heard the Ld counsel for defence and peruse the whole record. After perusal of record it appears that the record is pending for prosecution witness since, 02.07.2011. This case is based on police report filed by the informant namely, Sanjeet Kumar Sinha on dt. 08.07.2010. Cognizance was taken on 354/419 of the I.P.C. against above mentioned accused person. Accusation explained u/s- 354/419 of the</p>	

I.P.C. against accused person. After accusation the record is pending for prosecution witnesses. All the processes has been complied by the court regarding adducing witnesses i.e. Summon, B/W, N.B.W., Dasti Summon. But the prosecution fails to adduced any witnesses in support of prosecution during the course of trail. Even the informant himself fails to examine as a witness before the court. He fails his interest in this case. Despite him giving clear cut instruction for adducing evidence but he fails to do so. Prosecution was given last chance for adducing evidences and the prosecution witness was closed finally on dt. **24.02.2026**. Sufficient time has been given to the prosecution for adducing evidences. Since not a single witness has been adduced in this case and no incriminating material has been brought on record. On discussion of above facts and circumstances this court finds that there is lack of evidence and its a matter of no evidence.

Hence, the accused person namely, **Karelal Yadav** hereby acquitted from the offence punishable u/s- **354/419** of the I.P.C.

Since, accused person is on bail. So, their bailors are also discharged from the liabilities of their respective bail bonds.

Office clerk is directed to deposit the case record, to record room within stipulated time frame.
