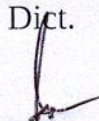
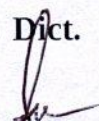

The said petition is moved today. Copy of bail petition is served to the ld. SDPO. Heard the ld. Defence counsel on behalf of accused person. The defence Counsel has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. No any bail application has been filed in any higher court. He was living outside of the state for his famaly livelihood. He is falsely implicated in this case due to land dispute. He did not make any pairvi due to transfer of the case from begusarai to teghra, so the learned court was pleased and cancel the bail bond of accused petitioner on 16-11-2022. The petitioner is surrendering suo-moto before the court. The petitioners is ready to furnish bail-bond as per directed by Ld. Court. On the submission, ld. Counsel prays to enlarge the accused on bail. Heard, Perused the case record. After perusal of the case record, it transpires that his bail-bond has been cancelled on 16-11-22. Cognizance has been taken of offences punishable u/s- 341/323/504/34 of I.P.C. Accused surrendered voluntarily. The accused pleaded not to commit such mistakes in the future. Thus, Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances of the case the aforesaid accused is directed to be released on bail, On furnishing bail bond of Rs. 5000X2 with two sureties of the like amount with condition to present till charge.
