ORDER

19-03-2026. Complainant has filed his attendance through his advocate, who has filed a complaint petition against three accused persons namely, *Roushan Afroz, Md. Talha @ Shammi and Md. Salim.*

Perused the case record, from perusal of the same it appears that the complainant has been examined on S.A. and during the course of inquiry total two inquiry witnesses namely, EW-1 *Talat Ahmad*, and EW-2 *Iradat Ahmad* have been examined.

Perused the complaint petition, S.A. of complainant and statement of two inquiry witnesses. From the above-said perusal, in brief, the grievance of the complainant is, as alleged, that the incident occurred on 09.12.2023, at 11:00 A.M. *Roushan Afroz, Md. Talha*, and *Md. Salim* arrived at the southwest boundary of my house armed with crowbars, spades, and hammers, and began demolishing the boundary wall. They proceeded to completely break down the wall. When the women of my household attempted to stop them, the perpetrators resorted to verbal abuse and profanity. After demolishing the boundary wall, they installed an iron gate in its place. The destruction of the boundary wall resulted in financial loss for me. I became aware of the incident only upon my return home. When I visited the police station to report the matter, proceedings were initiated under Section 107 of the Cr.P.C. The accused individuals are my neighbors. On the day of the incident, I had gone to *Begusarai* and returned around 2:00 P.M. At the time, only my wife and daughter were present at home. There is no pending litigation regarding this land dispute. They demolished the boundary wall for the purpose of creating a passageway. In 1982, an agreement was reached between my father and them, stipulating that they would not construct a passageway on this side. Further perusal reveals that the complainant and his inquiry witnesses have supported the complaint story. So, considering the facts and circumstances of

the case and materials available on record, this Court finds that a prima-facie case is made out only for the offense **u/s. 341, 447 & 504 of the I.P.C.** only against Accused namely **Roushan Afroz, Md. Talha @ Shammi and Md. Salim.**

The complainant is directed to file essential requisites within seven days for issue summon to the above-named accused persons for facing trial.
