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ORDER

1. The present Misc. Transfer (Criminal) Petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner for transfer of Mahila P.S. Case No. 46/2024, pending in the Court of the learned S.D.J.M., Naugachia, to any other competent court at Bhagalpur in the light of the order dated 08.10.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Patna in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 26663 of 2025.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for O.P. No. 02 as well as Ld. P.P for the State and perused the case record.

3. It is stated in the petition that the Hon'ble High Court, while disposing of the aforesaid anticipatory bail application was pleased to direct that in case either of the parties retracts from the terms and conditions of compromise, the learned court below may pass appropriate orders and further directed that, for the sake of justice, the aforesaid case be transferred from the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Naugachia to any other court of competent jurisdiction at Bhagalpur as assigned by the Principal District & Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur.

4. From the office report submitted by the Sheristedar, it appears that the present transfer petition has been filed in compliance with the aforesaid direction of the Hon'ble High Court and the case is required to be

transferred to a competent court at Bhagalpur as per administrative assignment by this Court.

5. It further appears from the record that Opposite Party No. 2, namely Sanam Bharti, has filed a petition stating therein that she has no objection to the transfer of the aforesaid case from the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Naugachia to a competent court at Bhagalpur.

6. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for O.P. No. 02 as well as Ld. P.P for the State. Perused the record, the present Misc. Transfer Petition, the office report submitted by the Sheristedar, the no-objection petition filed on behalf of Opposite Party No. 2 namely Sanam Bharti and the order dated 08.10.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Patna in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 26663 of 2025 arising out of Naugachia Mahila P.S. Case No. 46/2024. From perusal of the aforesaid order of the Hon'ble High Court, it appears that while disposing of the anticipatory bail application of the petitioner in connection with the aforesaid case, the Hon'ble High Court observed that the dispute between the parties was matrimonial in nature and the matter had been referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Patna High Court, where the mediation was reported to be successful and the terms and conditions of compromise were accepted between the parties. It further appears that the Hon'ble High Court directed that if either of the parties retracts from the terms and conditions of compromise, the learned court below may pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, and further directed that, for the sake of justice, Naugachia Mahila P.S. Case No. 46/2024 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Naugachia be transferred to any other court of competent jurisdiction at Bhagalpur as may be assigned by the Principal District & Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur. The office report also indicates that the present transfer petition has been filed in the light of the aforesaid direction of the Hon'ble High Court for administrative assignment of the case to a competent court at Bhagalpur. It further transpires from the record that Opposite Party No. 2 has filed a petition stating therein that she has no objection to the transfer of the

aforesaid case from the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Naugachia to a competent court at Bhagalpur.

7. Considering the direction of the Hon'ble High Court, the office report placed on record and the no-objection submitted by Opposite Party No. 2, this Court finds sufficient ground to allow the present Misc. Transfer (Criminal) Petition and to transfer the aforesaid case to a competent court at Bhagalpur in the interest of justice. Accordingly, the present Misc. Transfer (Criminal) Petition is hereby allowed and Mahila P.S. Case No. 46/2024 is hereby recalled from the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Naugachia and transferred to the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Bhagalpur for disposal in accordance with law. Let the record of the aforesaid case be called for from the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Naugachia forthwith and transmitted to the transferee court immediately. Accordingly, the present Misc. Transfer (Criminal) Petition stands disposed of.
