Order on the Bail Application:

Present: Mr. Abhinav Kumar Dubey, Ld. Addl. PP for the State.
Mr. Anil Basoya and Mr. M. Naushad, Ld. Counsel for the
applicant/accused.

(1). This is an application under section 483 BNSS 2023 for grant of regular bail, filed on behalf of the applicant/accused Amjad Ahmad.

(2). Reply already filed.

(3). Arguments heard.

(4). In brief the case of the prosecution is that ID on 'Uncle Delivery App' for services of online delivery was created by the applicant Amjad Ahmad; that the mobile phone used for creating the ID on the said App was recovered at the instance of the present applicant/accused; that the applicant/accused loaded the goods of the complainant from Nehru Place and instead of delivering the same at the destination address, took the same to his residence at Shaheen Bagh and took away the goods which were handed over for delivery purpose; and that the fake number plates were used on the vehicle by the applicant/

accused.

(5). Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused submits that the applicant/accused has not committed any offence and he is innocent. It is further submitted that the applicant/accused is in JC since 08.04.2026; that the allegations against the applicant/accused are false and frivolous and he has been falsely implicated in this case; that there is no direct or indirect evidence against the applicant/accused; that the accused is of tender age of 18-19 years; that the accused has not received the alleged amount of Rs.7,66,200/- from the complainant and there is no transactions between the complainant and the accused. It is further submitted that co-accused Bhupendra Singh has already been granted bail in this case by the Ld. CJM, South-East, Saket, New Delhi vide order dated 30.04.2026 and on the ground of parity, the applicant/accused may also be granted bail in this case. It is further submitted that investigation has been completed and the charge-sheet has already been filed in this case and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant/accused in further JC.

(6). Ld. Addl. PP for the State submits that the applicant/accused is a habitual offender and is involved in similar offences and the allegations are serious in nature.

(7). Heard. Submissions considered.

(8). The applicant/accused is stated to be aged about 18-19 years and he has been in custody since 08.04.2026. The co-accused has already been granted bail. The investigation has been completed and charge-sheet has already been filed by the IO and hence no useful purpose

would be served by keeping the applicant/accused in further incarceration. Considering the totality of the facts and circumstances, young age of the applicant/accused, the present application is **allowed** and the applicant/ accused **Amjad Ahmad** is **admitted to regular bail** in this case on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of **Rs.50,000/-with one sound surety** in the like amount to the satisfaction of the court, subject to the following conditions that:

- (i). He shall not leave the country without the permission of the Court, and if the passport has been issued on his name the same shall be submitted to the SHO concerned;
- (ii). He shall not try to tamper with the evidence or hamper the trial or try to influence the prosecution witnesses, in any manner;
- (iii). He shall furnish his present and permanent address with supporting documents along with an affidavit/undertaking to inform any change thereof without delay to the SHO concerned;
- (iv). He shall attend the trial regularly without any single default.

(9). **It is clarified that nothing mentioned in this order shall be a reflection on the merits of the case and all the observations as made in this bail order have been made only for the disposal of the bail application.**

(10). The bail application is accordingly **disposed of as allowed.**

(11). Copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent, for necessary intimation to the applicant/accused.

(12). A copy of this order be given *dasti* , as per rules.
