09-04-2026	The accused-petitioner Deepak Poddar who is in custody since 18-01-2026 has filed this bail petition in connection with Sabour P.S. Case No. 19/2026 registered under Sections 126(2), 190, 191(2), 329(4), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 352 BNS. On behalf of the petitioner a certificate has been given in para 3 of the bail petition that petitioner had not filed any bail petition in any form either in the court of learned Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur or before the Hon'ble High Court Patna. Further the petitioner has no criminal antecedent as per para 4 of the bail petition. Prosecution case in brief, as per the written application of the informant Sakal Devi is that on 17-01-2026 at about 4 O'Clock Manoj Poddar, Raju Poddar, Deepak Poddar, Usha Devi, Manisha Devi, Labbo Devi armed with came in her house armed with weapons like lathi, danda and Raju Poddar and Deepak Poddar came wearing fighter and started using abusive language and asked informant to do the land in which they have made hut, in their name. When informant refused to do so then the above named accused persons ran towards her to slap, punch and beat her with sticks and dragged her pulling her hair. When Subham Poddar, Prince Kumar, Nitish Kumar and Nutan Devi rushed for their rescue the above named accused persons started assaulting Subham Poddar, Prince Kumar and Nitish Kumar due to which they sustained head injury and were admitted in Referral Hospital, Sabour. Informant further stated that the accused persons also assaulted her and Nutan Devi and have also threatened them for dire consequences. Hence, the FIR. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence. It is further submitted that both the parties are relatives and there is land dispute between them. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case in between the parties. It is further submitted that petitioner is in custody since 18-01-2026 i.e. more than two months. On such basis, it has been prayed that the petitioner be	

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09-04-2026 Contd.P/2	enlarged on bail. On the other hand, learned Additional P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner. Heard both sides and perused the case diary. Petitioner is named in FIR. Injury report of Prince Kumar reveals lacerated wound of approx 2"x ¼" x skin deep over left parietal region, superficial abrasion of approx ¼"x 1/6" over nose, complain of pain in whole body, nature of injury is simple caused by hard blunt substance. Injury report of Nitish reveals lacerated wound of approx 2"x ¼" x skin deep over right parietal region, superficial abrasion of approx 1/2"x 1/4" over right great toe, complain of pain in whole body, nature of injury is simple caused by hard blunt substance. Injury report of Nutan Devi reveals complain of pain in whole body, nature of injury is simple caused by hard blunt substance. Injury report of Sakli Devi reveals scratch mark of approx 1" long over right knee, mild swelling over posterior part of right parietal region, complain of pain in whole body, nature of injury is simple caused by hard blunt substance. Injury report of Subham Kumar reveals NCCT Brain shows no bony fracture, X-Ray Spine, Right Shoulder shows no bony fracture, nature of injury is simple caused by hard blunt substance. Both the parties are relatives and there is land dispute between them. Moreover, there is case and counter case between both the parties and the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since from 18-01-2026 which is more than 2 ½ months. In the facts and circumstances as stated above, and considering the period of custody, it is directed that the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- (Ten thousands) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court with further condition that the petitioner shall co-operate in trial and shall mention his mobile number on the bail bond and shall not change his mobile number till the disposal of the case.
