25-03-2026	This is a petition filed on behalf of the above named accused-petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail who apprehends their arrest in connection with Sultanganj P.S. Case No. 36/2026 for offences punishable U/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 324(2), 324(6), 351(3), 352, 238, 3(5) BNS. On behalf of the petitioners a certificate has been given in para 2 of the bail petition that earlier no anticipatory or regular bail petition have been filed on their behalf either before the Court of the Ld. Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. In para-3 of bail petition, accused-petitioner has given certificate that they have no criminal antecedent. Prosecution case, as per written application of informant Abhishek Kumar, in brief, is that on 22-01-2026 at about 2 O'Clock in the afternoon, he along with Suraj Kumar was going to Sultanganj with his bike. Informant further stated that when he reached near Bhanga Bandh, two unknown miscreants attacked on him with lathi due to which he fell down from his motorcylcle and thereafter the miscreants started assaulting both of them and also snatched his mobile. In the meantime Shivam Kumar, an auto driver from informant's village came there and started to make video and seeing him make video miscreants also snatched his mobile and threatened him to delete the video. Informant further stated that the miscreants also assaulted with lathi on back of Suraj Kumar and they also dismantled the handle and also broke the gear of motorcyle. Informant further stated that one of the miscreant was having desi katta and other was having pistol with them. Informant further stated that they were rescued by the nearby people. He further stated that after seeing the video, nearby people identified them as Govind Yadav and Tempo Yadav . Hence, this FIR is lodged. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in this case. It has further been submitted that all the alleged sections are bailable except 303(2)and 338 of BNS and the same is not made out against the accused-petitioners as nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. On such basis, it has been prayed that the petitioners be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

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Contd...P/2 25-03-2026	On the other hand, learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner. Heard both the parties. Perused the case record and case dairy. Para-2 of the case diary is the re-statement of informant who reiterated the prosecution case. Para-6 and 7 of the case diary are the statements of witnesses who have also supported the prosecution case. No any video or audio is available on record as alleged in the FIR. Further, no any incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the accused-petitioners. Further no any injury report is available on record. All the sections as alleged are bailable except section 338 and 303(2) of BNS, which appears to be ornamental. In the above said facts and circumstances, the prayer of the anticipatory bail of the above named petitioners is allowed and it is directed to release the petitioners on anticipatory bail within 30 days of this order after filing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court with condition laid down U/S 482 (2) B.N.S.S.
