09-04-2026	The accused-petitioner Manish Kumar who is in custody since 14-03-2026 has filed this bail petition in connection with Sajour P.S. Case No. 51/2026 registered under Sections 87 BNS. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had not filed any bail petition in any form on previous occasion either in the court of learned Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner bears clean antecedent as per para 3 of the bail petition. The prosecution story in brief as per written application of informant namely Pushpa Devi in brief is that when her daughter Nilu Kumari went to market on 05-03-2026 and did not returned till night, they searched for her. She further stated that on 01-03-2026 one Manish Kumar had called on her husband's mobile and told that he wants to marry her daughter on which his husband denied. She further stated that she is fully confident that Manish has taken abducted her daughter with the intention of marrying her. The Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He further submitted that victim is major and she has stated in her statement U/S 183 BNS that she went with petitioner with her own will and has also got married with him. He further submitted that petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 14-03-2026. On these grounds, prayer has been made to grant bail to the petitioner. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the state a vehemently opposed the prayer for bail. Heard both sides, perused the case record as well as case diary. From perusal of photocopy of Marksheet of BSEB, Patna it appears that date of birth of victim is 20-02-2008 and she was major at the time of occurrence. Victim in her statement U/s 183 BNS	

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09-04-2026 Contd.P/2	has stated that on 05-03-2026 at about 4 p.m. she went to Bhagalpur along with petitioner Manish Kumar and got married with him and started living with him on rent. In the facts and circumstances as stated above, and considering the fact that victim is major and she got married with the petitioner with her own will, it is directed that the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- (Ten thousands) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court with further condition that the petitioner shall co-operate in trial and shall mention his mobile number on the bail bond and shall not change his mobile number till the disposal of the case.
