07-05-2026	The Petitioners namely Md. Samsat @ Md. Samsad Alam, Md. Altaf @ Abu @ Altaf Ansari, Md. Mahtab @ Pinku @ Mahtab Raza and Bibi Soni @ Soni apprehends their arrest in connection with Barari P.S. No 31/26 registered under Sections U/s 126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 109, 308(2), 303(2), 324(4)(5), 351(2)(3), 3(5) BNS. On behalf of the petitioners, a certificate has been given in para 2 of the bail petition that she has not filed any bail petition in any form on previous occasion either in the court of Learned Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioners bears clean antecedent. The prosecution story in brief as per written application of informant namely Md. Jamal is that on 15-02-2026, at about 08:30 p.m accused persons namely Md. Shamshad, Md. Altaf @ Adhu, Md. Mahtab @ Pinku, Bibi Rabiya and Soni came armed with lathi, danda and iron rod and Md. Altaf @ Adhu told to write the land in his name and threatened to kill him. Thereafter, they started to destroy the articles of the house and when informant protested they started assaulting him. When Md. Jabar, Raunak Afroz, Noor Jahan and her wife came for his rescue the accused persons also assaulted them due to which they got injured. Soni snatched Rs. 5,000/- from his pocket and also broke his phone. Accused persons also threatened them for dire consequences. Thereafter, he was taken to Sadar Hospital, Bhagalpur for treatment. The Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that they are innocent and have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case due to unequal partition of family property. He further submitted that the petitioner no. 2 and petitioner no. 4 have file a sanha petition against the informant and other accused	

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07-05-2026 Contd.P/2	petitioners. On these grounds, prayer has been made to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the prayer for bail. Heard both sides, perused the case diary and the case record. Petitioners are named in FIR. Informant in his re-statement para 2 of the case diary have reiterated the prosecution case. Statement of witnesses at para 3, 4, 5, 9 and 10 of the case diary reveals that these witnesses have fully supported the prosecution case. Injury Report of Rounak Afroz mentioned at para 41 of the case diary reveals patterned scratch wound over upper chest of size 4 cmx3cm and pain in whole body. Investigation is still pending against the petitioners. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances as discussed above, this court is of the opinion that petitioners do not deserve for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, their prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby Rejected. SD/- District & Additional Sessions Judge I
