

Court of Principal Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur.**Criminal Misc. Petition No. 26/2026**

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ORDER

25-03-2026

1. This Cr. Misc. Petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner Rahul Kumar @ Md. Rahul S/o Mojam, who is accused in connection with Jagdishpur P.S. Case No. 181/2025.

2. It has been submitted that above said petitioner was granted Regular bail by this court vide order dated 25-02-2026 passed in Bail Application No. 116/2026 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- with sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the court with condition that one of the surety of petitioner shall be the **parent of petitioner**. It has further been submitted that petitioner's parents are alive but they have no landed property due to which bail bonds of petitioner could not be furnished and he is languishing in judicial custody though he has been granted bail. Hence, a prayer has been made to amend the aforesaid condition imposed against the accused/petitioner to furnish the bail bonds to the extent that one of the bailor shall be the close relative (Naniya Saas) of the petitioner.

3. On the other hand learned P.P. has not opposed the prayer of the petitioner but at the same time he also submitted that petitioner may be directed to file an undertaking in support of his contention that one of his bailor is Naniya Saas.

4. In the facts and circumstances of the case, in view of the submissions, the condition for furnishing bail bonds as per order dated 25-02-2026 passed in Bail Application No. 116/2026 passed by this Court requires modification for the ends of justice. Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous Application is allowed and the condition as mentioned in order dated 25-02-2026 passed in Bail Application No. 116/2026 by this Court is modified to the extent only that one of the surety shall be the close relative (Naniya Sas) of the petitioner. Other conditions as imposed in the order dated 25-02-2026 passed in Bail Application No. 116/2026, which relates to Jagdishpur P.S. Case No. 181/2025 shall remain same. Further, the petitioner shall file an undertaking before the court at the time of furnishing bail bonds disclosing the name and details of his Naniya Sas who is one of his bailor.

5. Thus, with the aforesaid modification, this Criminal Miscellaneous Application stands disposed off.

6. Office is directed to inform the Court concerned at-once.
