07-04-2026	This is a petition filed on behalf of the above named accused-petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail who apprehension his arrest in connection with Sultanganj P.S. Case No. 43/2025 for offences punishable U/s 191 (2), 190, 329 (4), 126 (2), 115 (2), 109, 352, 351 (2) BNS. On behalf of the petitioner a certificate has been given in bail petition that earlier no anticipatory or regular bail petition has been filed on his behalf either before the Court of the Ld. Principal Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. In para-3 of bail petition, accused-petitioner has given certificate that he has no criminal antecedent. Prosecution case, as per FIR of informant Sumitra Devi, in brief, is that on on 30.01.2025 at about 7:00 O'clock, all FIR named accused persons entered into the house of informant and Anand Kumar assaulted Podin Bind by means of knife by which Modin Bind sustained stomach injury due to which blood started oozing out and Anuj Kumar and Subodh Kumar snatched silver chain of informant. Thereafter, on information police came and injured were taken to hospital for treatment and they threatened to kill if she would lodge any case. Hence, this FIR is lodged. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has further been submitted that save and except section 109, 126 (2) BNS, rest sections are bailable in nature and said sections are not made out against the accused-petitioner and petitioner is a farmer and he works in his mohalla and other places and other co-accused persons have granted anticipatory bail by the Ld. Predecessor Court vide in A.B.P. No. 1256/25 dated 21.06.2025. On such basis, it has been prayed that petitioner be enlarged on anticipatory bail. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner. Heard both the parties.

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Contd...P/2 07-04-2026	Perused the case record as well as case diary and on perusal the same it transpires that there is allegation against this accused-petitioner that he alongwith other co-accused persons have entered into the house of informant and assaulted Podin Bind by means of lathi, danda and knife by which he got stomach injured and they have also snatched silver chain of informant. Para-2 of the case is the re-statement of informant. Para- 3, 13 and 35 of the case diary are the statements of witnesses who have supported the prosecution story. Para-92 of the case diary is the injury report of injured Podin Bind reveals that the doctor has found lacerated bleeding wound over left inguinal region of size 3 cm x 1cm x 4 cm and doctor has opined that the nature of injury is simple. Para-97 of the case diary reveals that there is no criminal antecedents against accused-petitioner. Further, co-accused namely Anand Kumar, who assaulted the injured, has granted bail by the Ld. Trial Court on 26.03.2025 and other anticipatory bail of co-accused persons have granted by the Ld. Predecessor Court vide in ABP No. 1256/2025 dated 23.06.2025 and case of this petitioner is also based on similar footing. In the above said facts and circumstances, the prayer of the anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed and directed to release on anticipatory bail within 30 days of this order after filing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court with condition laid down U/S 482 (2) BNSS.
