18-04-2026	<p>The petitioners namely Deep Narayan Thakur, Janardan Thakur @ Ramprakash Thakur, Gopal Thakur and Rabindra Thakur @ Rabindra Prasad apprehends their arrest in connection with Sultanganj P.S. No 120/25 registered under Sections 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 352, 351(2), 324(4) BNS.</p> <p>On behalf of the petitioners, a certificate has been given in para 2 of the bail petition that earlier the petitioner have filed ABP-928/25 which was withdrawn on 19-05-2025 and thereafter the petitioners have not filed any bail petition in any form on previous occasion either in the court of Learned Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioners bear clean antecedent.</p> <p>The prosecution story on the basis of typed application of informant namely Naresh Yadav in brief is that on 23.03.2025 at about 10.20 A.M. when informant went at his field in Shivnandanpur, the accused persons acting under a pre-planned conspiracy and armed with deadly weapons, surrounded him with the intent to kill him . Thereafter, Deep Narayan Thakur along with 20-25 other accused persons were allegedly uprooting the informant's 'Khesari' crops and when the informant protested, Gopal Thakur commanded Deep Narayan Thakur, Bhupendra Thakur, Gopal Thakur, Janardan Thakur, Ravindra Thakur, Abhishek Kumar, Karan Kumar, Arjun Kumar Rahul Kumar, Raghuvir Kumar and 20-25 unidentified persons to kill informant. Upon the command of Gopal Thakur, Deep Narayan Thakur and Bhupendra Thakur allegedly struck on the informant's head with an iron rod, causing a bleeding head injury. Thereafter, Janardan Thakur and 20-25 unidentified persons attacked the informant and his son Jaisuri Kumar with lathi-danda due to which his son's right hand got fractured. Informant also sustained injuries to his shoulder and various parts of his body. Upon hearing noise nearby people came and rescued them. Informant further stated that cause</p>

of the incident is a land dispute between the parties. Hence the FIR.

The Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that they are innocent. He further submitted that this case is nothing, but counter blast of the case filed by one of the accused petitioner and the present case is lodged after a delay of 3-4 days which creates doubt. He further submitted that there is land dispute between both the informant and the petitioners. On these grounds, prayer has been made to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the state vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both sides, perused the case diary.

From perusal of case diary, it transpires that petitioners are named in FIR. Para-2 of the case diary is the re-statement of informant wherein he reiterated the prosecution story. Para 8 and 10 of the case diary are the statement of witnesses wherein they have fully supported the prosecution story. From perusal of injury report of Naresh Yadav available in the case diary reveals a lacerated wound of size approx (5 x1x1) cm on the right front-parietal region of the head, contusion and swelling over the right hand, As per report x-ray right hand, CXR, plate no-1987 on 24/03/2025 shows fracture of 5th metacarpal bone of right side done, as per report NCCT Brain plate no-456 on 23-03-25 shows no bony fracture seen and doctor opined nature of injury is grievous injury. From perusal of injury report of Jaisuri Kumar available in the case diary reveals contusion and swelling over right hand, as per report x-ray right hand, right forearm with wrist, plate no-1938 on 23/03/2025 done at JLNMCH Bhagalpur shows fracture 2nd and 3rd meta carpal right hand and doctor opined nature of injury is grievous injury.

Keeping in view the nature of the injury, the allegations alleged against the petitioners are serious in nature. So, I am of the view that petitioners do not deserve for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, their prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby **Rejected**.
