15.04.2026	A regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the above named accused-petitioner who is in judicial custody since 03.02.2026 in connection with Shahkund P.S. Case No. 06/2026 for the offence punishable U/s 126 (2), 127 (2), 115 (2), 118 (1), 352, 110, 3 (5) BNS. On behalf of petitioner a certificate has been given at para-2 of bail petition that earlier petitioner has not filed any anticipatory or regular bail petition either before Ld. Principal Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. A certificate has given at para-3 of bail petition that accused-petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Prosecution case, as per Fardbeyan of informant Sima Devi, in brief, is that on 30.12.2025 all FIR named accused-persons including this accused-petitioner called her son Ajay Mandal on their home and assaulted her son badly by means of sharp weapon, lathi and danda by which her son got injured. On 31.12.2025, they have kidnapped her son in injured condition and blood was oozing out by which her son became unconscious and thrown her son in unconscious condition at Chanan Pul Road. Thereafter, she got knowledge about the incident and injured was admitted in Tejas Hospital in critical condition and injured sustained injury in several parts of the body. Her son has been working at Hira Mandal from last two months and when he demanded his wages then they have assaulted her son. Hence, this FIR is lodged. The Ld. counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case. Further, submits that alleged sections are bailable in nature and except section 110 BNS, rest sections are bailable in nature and whole narration of this case is totally false and fabricated and only alleged by informant to harass the petitioner for illegal gain. Further, submits that petitioner

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Contd..../P-2 15.04.2026	is in judicial custody since 03.02.2026, hence, petitioner deserves bail. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner. Heard both the parties. Perused the case record as well as case diary and on perusal the same it transpires that there is allegation against this accused-petitioner that he alongwith other co-accused persons have called the son of informant at their house and assaulted her son badly by means of sharp weapon, lahti and danda by which her son got serious injury. On perusal of the injury report of injured Ajay Kumar Mandal doctor has opined that lacerated wound present over head, lacerated wound present around ear, swelling of eyes, fracture of nasal bone and doctor has opined the nature of injury is grievous caused by hard rod substance but doctor has not opined that these injuries are dangerous for life. Further, there is no any eye-witness of this case and all witnesses have reiterated the allegation levelled against the accused-petitioner. In the present case, after completion of investigation police has submitted charge-sheet U/s 126 (2), 127 (2), 115 (2), 118 (1), 352, 110, 3 (5) BNS against the accused-petitioner. Moreover, accused-petitioner has been languishing in judicial custody since 03.02.2026 which is more than two months. In the facts and circumstances as stated above and considering the period of custody, petitioner is directed to be <i>released on bail after framing of charge</i> on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty thousand) with two surety of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court with conditions: (1) One of the bailor must be close relative of the petitioner. Sd/- Additional Sessions Judge II Bhagalpur.
