

State Vs. Vivek etc.

Present: Ms.Dipika, APP for the State assisted by Sh.Abhinav Ghangas, Advocate for complainant and victim.

Accused Sonu on bail (not present today) represented by Sh.Jasvinder Singh, Advocate.

Accused Vivek on bail (not present today) represented by Sh.Naveen Kundu, Advocate.

Today the case was fixed for awaiting further order of Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court. At this stage, two separate applications seeking exemption on behalf of accused Sonu and Vivek moved. In view of the contents mentioned in the applications, personal appearance of accused Sonu and Vivek is exempted for today only.

Order dated 30.04.2026 passed by Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in CRM-M-11608-2026 placed on record. In view of order dated 30.04.2026 passed by Hon'ble High Court in CRM-M-11608-2026 which is as under:-

“For the foregoing reasons, the petition is allowed, FIR No. 72 dated 15.06.2019, under Sections 66-D of IT Act, 2000 and 468 of IPC, P.S.13/17, Panipat (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings including the police report/charge-sheet (Annexure P-2), and Magistrate trial No.CHI/1155/2020 (Annexure P-4) and consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 19.02.2026 (Annexure P-5) are quashed auq the petitioners”.

As per order passed by Hon'ble High Court (supra), the FIR of the present case along-with the consequential proceedings arising

therefrom on the basis of compromise, has been quashed. In view of quashing of FIR, this case cannot be proceeded further, being the consequential proceedings, hence, file be consigned to the record room after due compliance in view of order dated 30.04.2026 passed by Hon'ble High Court. Accused persons as well as their surety bonds stands discharged. File be consigned to the record-room after due compliance.
