05-06-2026	This is a petition filed on behalf of the above named accused-petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail who apprehension their arrest in connection with Sanhaua P.S. Case No. 30/2026 for offences punishable U/s 126 (2), 118 (1), 109, 303 (2), 76, 351 (2), 351 (3), 3 (5) BNS. On behalf of the petitioners a certificate has been given in bail petition that earlier no anticipatory or regular bail petition has been filed on her behalf either before the Court of the Ld. Principal Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. In para-3 of bail petition, accused-petitioners have given certificate that petitioners have no criminal antecedents and petitioner No. 2 & 3 have one criminal antecedents. Prosecution case as per FIR of informant, in brief, is that on 10.03.2026 at about 11:00 a.m. she was uprooting OL from her filed, in the meanwhile, all FIR named accused persons including these accused-petitioners altogether having with lathi and weapons with intention to kill started assaulting by means of lathi and Jira Devi snatched gold Chakti from her neck. Govind Sharma has assaulted on her head by means of iron stick. Tinku Sharma and other co-accused persons have also assaulted her husband by means of lathi by which her husband got unconscious and fell down on land and they fled away after seeing the villagers and threatened to kill if she lodged any case. On information, police came injured were taken to Sanhaua hospital for treatment and from there injured were referred to Mayaganj hospital. These accused-persons are veteren and they have done such type of offence with her father-in-law in which a case bearing FIR No. 39/2019 is lodged. Hence, this FIR is lodged. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. It has further been

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Contd...P/2 05-06-2026	submitted that petitioner No. 4 is handicap and there is no negative evidence against the accused-petitioners and petitioner No. 2 has also lodged a case bearing Sanhaua P.S. Case No. 34/2026. On such basis, it has been prayed that petitioners be enlarged on anticipatory bail. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners. Heard both the parties. Perused the case record as well as case diary and on perusal the same it transpires that there are allegations against these accused-petitioners that they alongwith other co-accused persons with intention to kill assaulted the informant and her husband by means of lathi and iron stick by which they got injured when informant was uprooting OL from her field. On perusal of injury report of injured Binita Devi the doctor has found no bony/parenchymal lesion. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has filed a photograph of injured Tinku Sharma which shows that he is also got injured badly. Para-12 of the case diary reveals that there are free fighting between the parties in which both sides injured. Further, petitioner No. 2 Jira Devi has also lodged a case bearing Sanhaua P.S. Case No. 34/2026 against the informant and others. Further, criminal antecedents of these accused-persons are not mentioned in the case. However, the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners has mentioned that except petitioners No. 2 & 3, rest accused-petitioners have no criminal antecedents. Further, occurrence took place on petty issue . In the above said facts and circumstances, the prayer of the anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed and directed to release on anticipatory bail within 30 days of this order after filing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court with condition laid down U/S 482 (2) BNSS with conditions :- (1) that one of the bailors must be close relatives of the petitioners. (2) that petitioners shall physically present on each and every date before the Ld. Trial Court till framing of charge. Sd/- Additional Sessions Judge-II Bhagalpur
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
