15-05-2026	The petitioner namely Rahul Kumar Singh @ Rahul Ranjan who is in custody since 23-02-2026 has filed this bail petition in connection with Pirpainty P.S. Case No. 77/2026 registered under Sections 64 of BNS. On behalf of the petitioner a certificate has been given in para 2 of the bail petition that the petitioner has not filed any bail petition in any form on previous occasion either in the court of Learned Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur or before the Hon'ble High Court Patna. Further the petitioner has no criminal antecedent as per para 3 of the bail petition. Prosecution case as per written application of informant-cum-victim in brief is that she is living in her maykaa for the last five years and she got acquainted with one Rahul Kumar trapped her in a web of love by proposing marriage. She further stated that on 18-02-2026 at about 8 p.m. Rahul Kumar called her and forcefully made physical relationship with her and told to go back to her home. When she refused to go back home he stuffed cloth in her mouth and assaulted her and also threatened her. Thereafter, she got fainted and she was later on found by her father in maize field. Hence, the FIR. The Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submitted that the case has been filed as victim's father had took Rs. 10,000/- from petitioner's father and when petitioner's father asked to give the money and due to this controversy arose. He further submits that petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 23-02-2026. So, the petitioner may be granted bail. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the state duly assisted by Ld. Counsel on behalf of informant opposed the prayer for bail. Heard both sides and perused the case diary and case record. Petitioner is named in FIR. Para 3, 4, 79, 80 and 81 of the case diary are the statements of witnesses who have supported the prosecution case. Statement of victim recorded u/s 180 BNSS in which the victim stated that Rahul Kumar trapped her in a web of love by proposing marriage he forcefully made physical relationship with her and also refused to marry her. Charge-sheet has been submitted	

15-05-2026 Contd.P/2	against this petitioner U/s 126(2), 15(2), 69 of BNS. Moreover, the DNA Report and FSL report is not yet obtained. Keeping in view the nature of the offence, severity of punishment and the allegation against the petitioner is serious in nature. So, I am of the view that applicant/petitioner does not deserve for bail. Accordingly, his prayer for bail is hereby Rejected. SD/- District & Additional Sessions Judge I Bhagalpur.
