This is an application for grant of regular bail U/s 483 BNSS 2023 (corresponding to section 439 Cr.P.C), filed on behalf of above-named accused-petitioner, who is in custody since 26-02-2026 in connection with Babarganj P.S. Case No. 49/2025, for the offences punishable U/s 126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 109, 190, 191(2), 191(3) of BNS and U/s 27 of Arms Act.

2. Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and learned Addl.P.P for the State.

3. A report has been received from the Court of Ms. Sadaf Mustafa, J.M.- I Class, Bhagalpur and on perusal thereof it transpires that the case has been committed to the Court of Sessions.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner orally submitted that the case has been committed to the court of Sessions, Bhagalpur and hence the petitioner does not want to press this bail application. Prayer has been made to permit the petitioner to withdraw this bail application.

4. Hence, prayer of petitioner is allowed.

5. Accordingly, this bail application is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioner is given liberty to file the fresh bail petition before the concerned court.
