ORDER

02-06-2026 An application for grant of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of the above named accused petitioners namely **1. Katki Yadav 2. Santosh Yadav @ Santosh Kumar Yadav 3. Suraj Yadav 4. Manoj Yadav and 5. Dablu Yadav @ Vibhash Kumar** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with **Lodipur P.S. Case no. 35/2026** relating to offences punishable u/Ss 191(2), 190, 126(2), 109, 352, 351(2) of the B.N.S., pending in the learned Court of S.D.J.M., Bhagalpur, is put up and moved.

Heard Mr. Rakesh Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners as well as Mr. Babar Ansari, learned Addl. P.P. for the State.

The prosecution story, in short, is that on 20-02-2026 at about 08:00 am all the six named accused persons including the petitioners herein brutally assaulted the informant on his head by means of *farsa* and *dabiya* causing bleeding injury and also extended threatening to eliminate him.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, apart from taking the pleas of innocence and false implication, submitted that accused petitioner no. 01 and 02 bears one criminal case and other accused petitioners have clean criminal antecedent. He further submitted that informant and others brutally assaulted Chaura Devi and her husband Katki Yadav, who is petitioner no. 01 herein, for which Lodipur P.S. case no. 36/2026 was registered and present case has been filed as a counterblast and prays to extend the privileges of anticipatory bail to the petitioners which is vehemently opposed by the learned Addl. P.P. for the State.

Heard both sides and perused the case record from which it transpires that petitioners and another are named in the F.I.R. and carry allegation of assaulting the informant on his head by means of sharp cutting weapons. The injury report of informant Suttan Yadav would reveal that doctor has found only one injury of size 6 cm x 1 cm on the mid of his scalp and prescribed investigation for N.C.C.T Head whose report shows scalp swelling with small hematoma over the left parietal convexity without underlying calvarial fracture or intracranial haemorrhage along with bilateral maxillary sinus mucosal thickening

which have been opined as simple in nature caused by hard and blunt force. Though there is no whispering of causing injury to any other person in the F.I.R. but the informant and other witnesses, in their respective statements before the I.O., stated that one Suresh Yadav also sustained injuries at the hands of accused persons. However, the injury report of said Suresh Yadav shows no bony fracture in his right elbow and the same has been also been opined as simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. There is case and counter case between the parties and none of the accused petitioners carries any specific allegation. Therefore, taking into account the nature of injuries and case and counter case between the parties, this Court is inclined to extend the privileges of anticipatory bail to all the above named petitioners.

Hence, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail made on behalf of accused petitioners namely **1. Katki Yadav 2. Santosh Yadav @ Santosh Kumar Yadav 3. Suraj Yadav 4. Manoj Yadav and 5. Dablu Yadav @ Vibhash Kumar** is hereby ***allowed***. It is hereby directed that in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within 30 days from the receipt of a copy of this order, the accused petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand rupees only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below. Petitioners are directed to file an ***undertaking*** that they will not misuse the privileges of bail, will cooperate in the trial and are further directed to furnish their respective mobile numbers with direction that neither they will change the mobile number nor turn off the mobile without information to the court.
