26-05-2026	The petitioner namely Gurudev Kumar Sah @ Guru apprehends his arrest in connection with Sanhoulla P.S. No 126/24 registered under Sections 87 BNS. On behalf of the petitioners, a certificate has been given in para 2 of the bail petition that the petitioner has not filed any bail petition in any form on previous occasion either in the court of Learned Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner bears clean antecedent. The prosecution story in brief on the basis of written application of informant Kalicharan Sah is that on 26-07-2024, at about 9 O'clock in the morning, her daughter Soni Kumari went to school for studying but did not returned. When they along with other relatives started searching her daughter then they got to know that on Gurudev Kuamr Sah has abducted her daughter with the intention of marrying her and Gurudev Kuamr Sah's father Om Prakash Sah and mother Lalita Devi have helped him in abduction of her daughter. Hence, this FIR. The Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he is innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submitted that there was love affairs in between victim and petitioner, she was major and she willingly left her house and went along with the petitioner. He further submitted that at present petitioner is living happily along with her husband in her matrimonial home On these grounds, prayer has been made to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the state opposed the prayer for bail. Heard both sides, perused the case diary and case record. Victim in her statement U/s 183 BNS stated that she voluntarily left her parental home and went with Gurudev Kumar Sah with her own will and they got married on 25-07-2024. She also stated that nothing wrong has happened with her. Victim was aged about 17 yrs 5 months on the date of occurrence but she has almost on	

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26-05-2026 Contd.P/2	the verge of majority exercising her willful choice to live along with the petitioner. Further victim physically appeared before the court along with her mother-in law and father-in-law and stated that she has got married with petitioner and have been living happily in her sasural and she is also pregnant at present. Victim present in the court further stated that she has no objection if anticipatory bail be granted to the petitioner. Therefore, considering the fact that victim has got married with the petitioner with her own will and is happily living in her matrimonial home and is also pregnant at present, the anticipatory bail application of petitioner is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within four weeks from the date of receipt/production of this order, the above named petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned trial court subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482 (2) of B.N.S.S. with further condition that petitioner must continue to provide all basic necessities and medical care to the victim and any report of neglect on behalf of victim may lead to cancellation of bail.
