05-06-2026	This is a petition filed on behalf of the above named accused-petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail who apprehension their arrest in connection with Jagdishpur P.S. Case No. 183/2021 for offences punishable U/s 341, 323, 307, 354B, 447, 504, 506/34 IPC On behalf of the petitioners a certificate has been given in bail petition that earlier no anticipatory or regular bail petition has been filed on their behalf either before the Court of the Ld. Principal Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. In para-3 of bail petition, accused-petitioners have given certificate that they have no criminal antecedents. Prosecution case, as per FIR of informant Vijay Kumar Mandal, in short, is that on 02.06.2021 at about 07:00 a.m. a noise was going on near his house and on hearing noise he reached there and saw that all FIR named accused-persons including these accused-petitioners having with lathi, danda and iron rod in their hands were abusing and Sagar Mandal caught the hand of his sister and told to forcibly marry with her. On objection, with intention to kill Sagar Mandal has assaulted on his head by means of iron rod and Shravan Mandal assaulted on his by means of lathi, Mahesh Mandal has also assaulted him by means of lathi. Shravan snatched chain and Sagar Mandal tried to disrobe the modesty with his sister. On noise, Ramdhani Mandal and Dharmendra Mandal came and taken the injured in hospital. Hence, this FIR is lodged. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has further been submitted that both parties are relatives to each other and except section 307 and 354B IPC, rest sections are bailable in nature which are ornamental added to make the cognizable and non bailable. On such basis, it has been prayed that petitioners be enlarged on anticipatory bail. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners. Heard both the parties.

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Contd...P/2 05-06-2026	Heard both sides and perused the record as well as case diary and on perusal the same it transpires that there are allegations these accused-petitioners they have assaulted the informants and his family members by means of lathi, danda and iron rod by which informant and his family members got injured. The final injury of injured is not available on record but there are direct allegations of assaulting the informant and his family members by means of lathi, danda and iron rod by which they got injured against the accused-petitioners. Para- 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, 34, 37, 44, 54, 79, 100, 108, 115 of the case diary have also supported the allegations levelled against the accused-petitioners. Further, police has also found the case true against these accused-petitioners. Keeping in view the nature of the offence, complicity & conduct of the accused petitioners, severity of punishment and submissions of the learned counsel for the parties, the allegation against the petitioners are serious in nature. So, I am of the view that applicants/petitioners do not deserve for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, their prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby Rejected. Sd/- Additional Sessions Judge-II Bhagalpur
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
