This is an application for release of original FDR in sum of Rs. 10,000/- filed on behalf of surety Smt. Kamlesh.

Sh. Jitender Kumar, Ld. Counsel for surety/
applicant.

Ld. Counsel for surety submits that Smt. Kamlesh stood surety for accused Dinesh @ Sunny @ Suresh and she had filed bail bonds under Sec. 437A Cr.PC. He further submits that the judgment in the present case was pronounced by this court on 31.05.2025 and the surety bonds were valid for a period of six months only and the said period of six months has already expired and hence she should be discharged as a Surety from the present case and original FDR in sum of Rs. 10,000/- should be released to the surety.

Ld. Addl PP for the State submits that he has no objection if the surety is discharged in the present case and no appeal has been filed in the present case.

I have heard the submission and perused the record.

As per the record, judgment in the present case was pronounced by this court on 31.05.2025. The bail bonds filed by the surety under Sec. 437A Cr.PC were valid only for a period of

six months. The period of six months of the validity of surety bonds has already expired. No appeal has been filed in the present case.

In view of the facts and circumstances, the present application is hereby **allowed**.

Surety namely Smt. Kamlesh is hereby discharged from the present case. Original FDR in sum of Rs. 10,000/- be released to surety Smt. Kamlesh against acknowledgment after verifying her identity.

The application is disposed off accordingly.

Copy of this order be given dasti to the surety.
