JUDGMENT

1. Joint Petition has been filed on behalf of Jayant Anand @ Jayant Singh (husband) and Jyoti Kumari (wife) under Section 13-1B(2) of the Hindu Marriage Act for the dissolution of their marriage through a decree of divorce by mutual consent.

2. The petitioners in their joint petition and oral evidence stated that they were married on 15-02-2013 according to Hindu Rites & Customs in Bhagalpur district. Parties are Hindu by religion. They have no children from this marriage.

3. Petitioners stated that they have been living separately since 30-06-2018 due to differences and that there are no chances of reconciliation. They have not cohabited as husband and wife since the day of their separation.

4. The parties were counselled, but they are determined to get the marriage dissolved. The joint statement of the parties has been recorded separately (Exbt. P-1/PW-1 and Exbt. P-3/PW-2), which shall be read as part and parcel of this judgment. Identity documents including Aadhaar cards were produced and

17,00,000/- has been mutually agreed upon between them. out of this, petitioner No.1 have paid a total of 11,00,000/- to petitioner No. 2 through two Demand Drafts and today he have paid the remaining 6,00,000/- to petitioner No. 2 through Demand Draft No. 000027, dated 13-05-2026 and there are no transactions remaining. There is no pending case between them.

6. I am satisfied that petitioners have made the joint statement voluntarily without any fear, pressure, or undue influence. There is no collusion between the parties. The marriage has broken down irretrievably.

7. In view of the foregoing, the petition is allowed. The marriage between Jayant Anand @ Jayant Singh and Jyoti Kumari is dissolved by a decree of divorce by way of mutual consent in terms of Section 13-B(2) of the Act.
